ORDINANCE NO. 1498

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND RE-ENACT SECTION 21-16-04.1 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF JAMESTOWN, NORTH DAKOTA, PERTAINING TO PARKING OF TRAILERS, MOTOR HOMES, ETC.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JAMESTOWN, NORTH DAKOTA, that Section 21-16-04.1 of the Code of the City of Jamestown, North Dakota, is hereby amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

SECTION 21-16-04.1. Parking trucks two ton or larger, buses, trailers, etc., on streets regulated.

It is unlawful to park any trucks two ton or larger, buses, trailers of any type, semitrailers, truck tractors, motor homes, RV's, camper trailers, implements of husbandry, construction vehicles, or commercial vehicles two (2) tons or larger on any street, boulevard or alley in any residential district of the city, nor shall any such vehicle be parked overnight on any street, boulevard or alley in any district of the city, provided that such vehicles may so park on such street, boulevard or alley under the following circumstances:

- (1) Such vehicles loading or unloading cargo or passengers may be so parked long enough to complete their loading or unloading.
- (2) Such regulations shall not apply to any vehicle being used during repair, maintenance or any construction project in progress on any such street, boulevard or alley.
- (3) It shall be lawful to park motor homes, RV's, camper trailers, other trailers of any type, except semitrailers, otherwise properly parked, on a street in any district of the city on a seasonal basis between April first through October thirty-first of each year. No vehicle shall be parked in the following locations:
 - a. Within thirty (30) feet of any intersection of two (2) streets or the intersection of an alley and a street.
 - b. In areas or locations where parking is otherwise prohibited or limited by city ordinance or state law.
- (4) Motor homes and camper trailers may be parked for 14 days provided the motorhome or camper trailer is parked on the street directly in front of the owners residence between April first through October thirty-first of each year.
- (5) Any trailer parked on any city street under part 3 of this Section must be equipped with red reflectors on the rear of the trailer and on the front of trailers parked facing oncoming traffic.
- (6) Notwithstanding the above and foregoing, it shall not be a violation of this section for a commercial vehicle, otherwise properly parked, to park on a street in any district during the hours that actual service is being provided at or upon premises fronting such street.
