ORDINANCE NO. 1413

An ordinance amending Section 22-15.1 of the Code of the City of Jamestown, North Dakota, which sets forth regulations and requirements possessing a loaded firearm in a vehicle in the City of Jamestown.

WHEREAS, the City Police Department of the City of Jamestown, North Dakota, regulates firearm usage in the City of Jamestown which now requires updating to better reflect the law set forth in the North Dakota Century Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordered by the City Council of the City of Jamestown, North Dakota, that Section 22-15.1 of the Jamestown City Code, be amended and re-enacted as follows:

Sec. 22-15.1. Firearms loaded in vehicle.

An individual may not keep or carry a loaded firearm in or on any motor vehicle within the city. An individual violating this section is guilty of a class B misdemeanor. This prohibition does not apply to:

- (a) A member of the armed forced of the United States or national guard, organized reserves, state defense forces, or state guard organizations while possessing the firearm issued to the member by the organization and while on duty;
- (b) A law enforcement officer as defined in Section 12.1-01-04 of the North Dakota Century Code, as amended, except while the officer is engaged in hunting or trapping activities with a rifle or shotgun.
- (c) An individual possessing a valid North Dakota concealed weapons license or valid license issued by another state authorizing the individual to carry a firearm or dangerous weapon concealed if that state permits a holder of a valid North Dakota concealed weapons license to carry a firearm or dangerous weapon concealed in that state without obtaining a similar license from that state, except while that individual is in the field engaged in hunting or trapping activities.
- (d) A security guard or private investigator properly licensed to carry firearms.
- (e) An individual possessing a valid special permit issued pursuant to Section 20.1-02-05 of the North Dakota Century Code.
