On **February 4, 2019**, garbage and recycling collection will transition to a four day collection schedule: Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. The City Council approved the collection schedule at its January meeting.

View the enclosed revised garbage and recycling collection maps to determine if your collection day will change. Garbage is collected weekly. Recycling is collected every other week. Collection occurs on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, or Thursdays depending on where you live.

Schedule A begins the week of February 4. Schedule B begins the week of February 11.

Carts must meet these criteria to be collected.

- Place cart for collection by 6:30 a.m. on your collection day;
- Place the cart next to the curb with the arrows pointed toward the collection point (street);
- Set the carts four (4) feet apart and from any obstruction with a minimum of three (3) feet of clearance;
- Close the cart lid completely. Items and bags next to the cart are not collected.

During snow emergencies, collection can be delayed. Please be patient and keep your cart off the street. If your cart collection is missed during a snow emergency, set your cart out the next morning for collection. **During holidays**, watch for public service announcements and view the recycling collection calendar.

NOTE: To avoid late fees, Utility Bill payments for the full amount due must be received by City staff inside City Hall before 5:00 p.m. on or before the 15th of each month, or the business day closest to the 15th if the 15th falls on a weekend. Beginning January 1, 2019, the late payment fee increased to \$25.00 plus 1% of the overdue balance for services.
