

City of Jamestown, ND  
Notice of Public Hearing

The City of Jamestown received a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) from the State of North Dakota Division of Community Services (DSC). CDBG funds are intended to provide decent housing, suitable living environments, and economic opportunities, principally for low/very low-income persons through rehabilitation and preservation, economic/job development, and public facilities improvement.

The project and funding level considered was \$100,000 for the Main Street Façade Improvements, Project 4455-SL18-MS.

It is estimated that approximately 51% of the funds benefited low/very low-income persons.

Displacement of neighborhood persons or businesses did not occur, and no housing units were demolished or converted because of the above-mentioned projects.

**A public hearing will be held at 5:00 pm on September 8, 2020, at City Hall, 102 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave SE, Jamestown, ND,** to obtain citizen views and to respond to proposals and questions related to the performance of the City of Jamestown in carrying out its community development responsibilities. Written comments are also welcome and must be received at City Hall, 102 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave SE, Jamestown, ND 58401 or [info@JamestownND.gov](mailto:info@JamestownND.gov) by the close of the public hearing. Oral and written comments will be considered to enhance the City of Jamestown in carrying out its community development responsibilities.
