POLICE & FIRE COMMITTEE

- 1. Ordinance No. 1560, introduced by Council Member Kamlitz ,to amend and re-enact Sections 22-17, 22-17.1 and 22-17.2 pertaining to sale of tobacco products.
- 2. Ordinance No. 1561, introduced by Council Member Schloegel, to amend and reenact Section 5-6 pertaining to persons under twenty-one years of age prohibited from using alcoholic beverages or entering licensed premises; penalty.

PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE

Chair Steele convened the meeting at 4:18 p.m.

City Engineer Dillman led discussion regarding stormwater at the MGM Trailer Park Area. Mayor Heinrich moved to recommend the City Council approve a hydraulics study by Interstate Engineering for the northeast watershed area and the MGM trailer court at an approximate cost of \$3,000. Seconded by Council Member Schloegel. Unanimous aye vote. Motion carried.

City Engineer Dillman and Water Superintendent Joe Rowell provided information on the Backflow Prevention Cross Connection Program. Rowell stated that the City is in compliance for public buildings, but needs an ordinance for private buildings.

City Engineer Dillman provided project updates.

Sanitation Foreman O'Neill provided an update on citywide cleanup and reminded residents that they will leave cardboard, clothing, household garbage, and anything that normally goes in household garbage or recycling carts, but will collect construction and demolition debris. O'Neill stated that the property owner must properly dispose of anything left after the clean up week.
