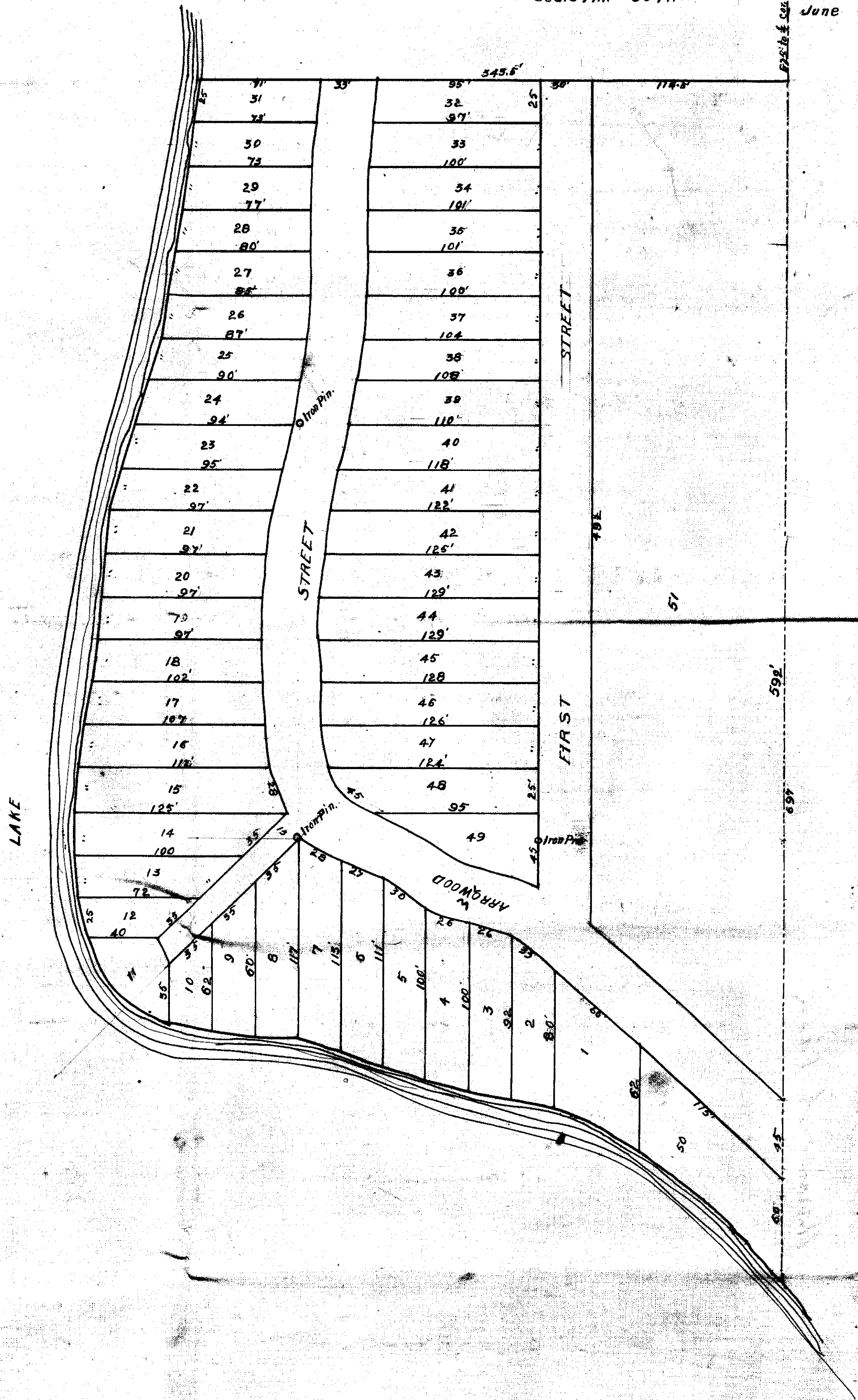


W PLAT OF

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS; That F.L. NICHOLS, of Kensal, Stutsman County, North Dakota, the owner and proprietor of the following described land, that part of Lot No. 5, Section No. 7, Township No. 144 N., Range No. 64 W. 5th Meridian, Stutsman County, North Dakota, and is more particular described as follows; to-wit:

Beginning at a point five hundred twenty-five (525) feet South of $\frac{1}{4}$ corner for Secs. No. 7 & 8, T. 144 N. R. 64 W. Thence South, along the section line between said Secs 7 & 8, a distance of Six hundred ninety-seven (697) feet to lake shore, thence North-Westerly along the lake shore a distance of Nine hundred eighty-five (985) feet, thence East Three hundred forty-three and five tenths (343.5) feet, to place of beginning, and as shown on the annexed plat, containing five $\frac{2}{10}$ (5.2) acres, Have caused the same to be surveyed and platted into lots and streets as shown on the annexed plat, to the end and purpose that the same may be recorded as such plat according to the provisions of the laws of the State of North Dakota; and do hereby donate and dedicate to the public use forever all of the Streets and avenues shown on the annexed plat.
