I, A. J. Lee, a Registered Professional Engineer, Hereby Certify that this plat is a true and correct representation of Auditor's Plat No. 1, in Jamestown, North Dakota, as surveyed and platted by me in accordance with the statutes of the State of North Dakota and ordinances of the City of Jamestown, North Dakota, in such case made and provided.

The land platted in said Auditor's Plat No. 1 lays in the N $\frac{1}{2}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 31, T 140 N, R 63 W, and is more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the northwest corner of said southwest quarter, thence East 1146.62 feet to the right-of-way of the Midland Continental Railroad, thence South 39° 53' East along said right-of-way a distance of 577.31 feet, thence West a distance of 1104.41 feet, thence South a distance of 683.71 feet, thence North 44° 00' West a distance of 186.18 feet, thence North 64° 00' West a distance of 279 feet, thence West a distance of 33 feet to the section line, thence North along the section line a distance of 870.5 feet to the point of beginning.
