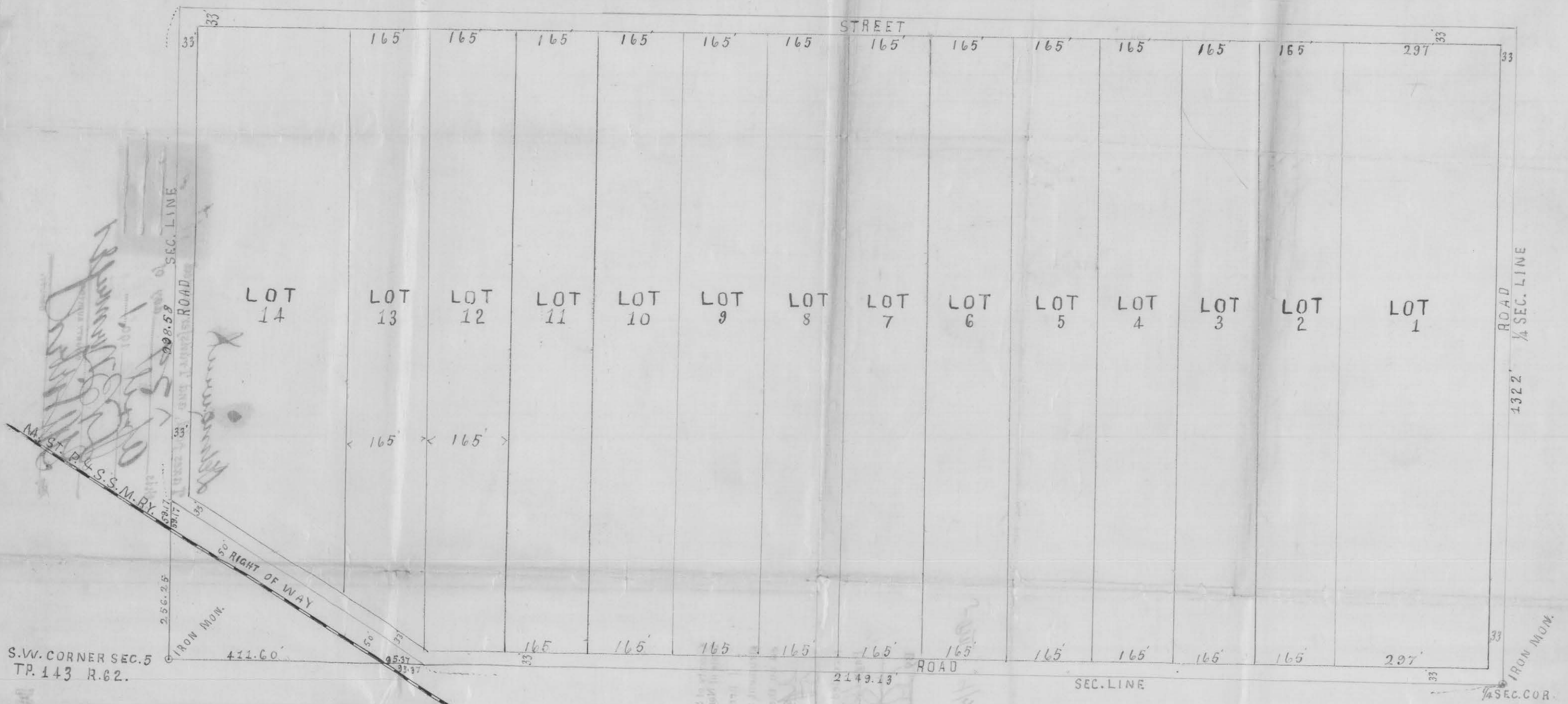


BROWN'S ADDITION TO COURTENAY N. D.
