Description of lands in First Addition to the Plat of the Cleveland Cemetery in Section 4-139-67, described as follows.

Commencing at a point 327 feet West and 33 feet South of N E corner Sec. 4-139-67, thence west 281.5 feet, thence south at an angle of 90° with the last described line a distance of 105.7 feet to north N.P. Right of Way line, thence east 281.7 feet along said north N.P. Right of Way line, thence north 118.5 feet to point of beginning, said tract of land containing Seventy two one hundredths (0.72) of an acre, more or less.

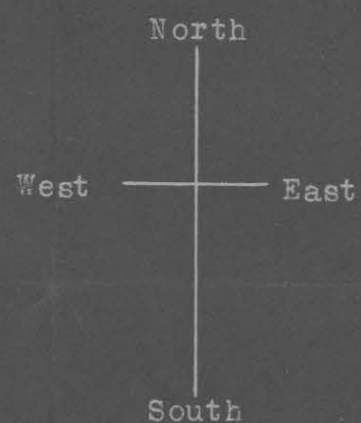
