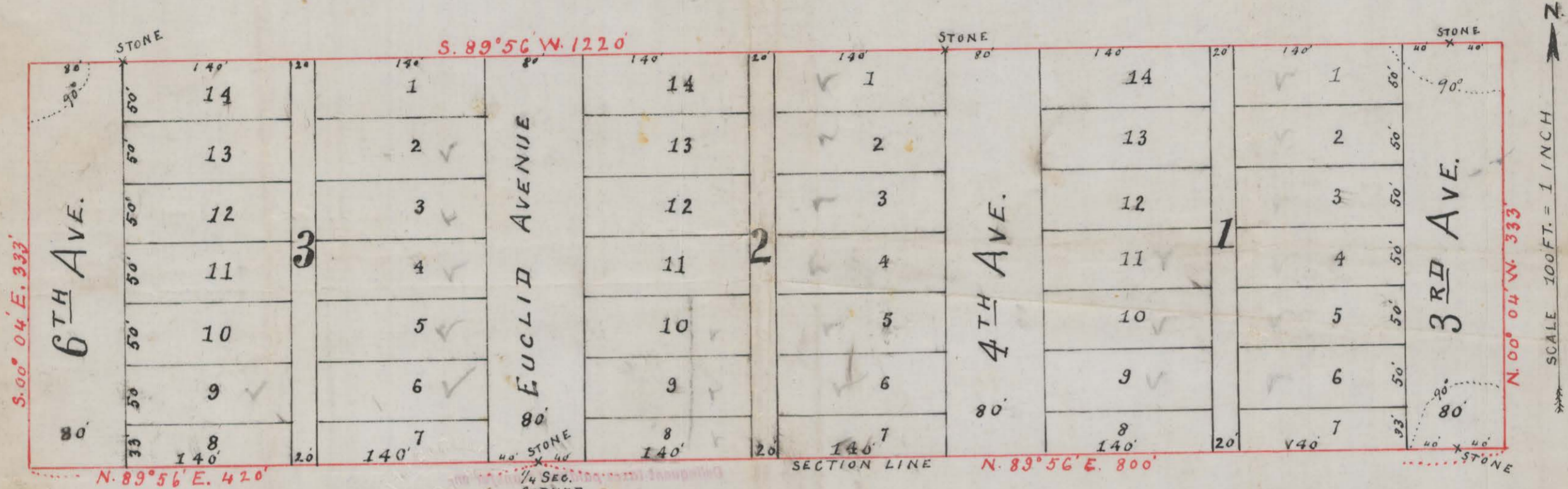


# COLLIN'S ADDITION TO CLEVELAND NORTH DAKOTA.

Collins of the County of Stutsman and State of North Dakota being owner and proprietors of a tract of land situated in the south half of the south half of section 34 Township 140 Range 67 in Stutsman County, North Dakota; more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the quarter section corner on the south line of said section 34 T<sup>140</sup> R<sup>67</sup> Thence north 89 degrees 56 minutes East 800 feet Thence north 4 minutes West 333 feet Thence south 89 degrees 56 minutes west 1220 feet Thence south 4 minutes East 333 feet Thence north 89 degrees 56 minutes East 1220 feet to point of beginning, containing 9.32 acres, have caused the same to be surveyed and platted in the manner shown on the annexed map as Collins' Addition to Cleveland, North Dakota and we do hereby donate and dedicate to the public use forever, all the avenues, streets and alleys thereon shown.
