I, Donald Wenaas, a Registered Professional Engineer and Land Surveyor in the State of North Dakota, and as Surveyor of the attached plat of COUNTRY ESTATES ADDITION to the City of Jamestown, North Dakota, do declare and make known that said plat is a part of the S.W. 1/4 of Section 24, T140N, R64W, in Stutsman County, North Dakota, and is more particularly described as follows:

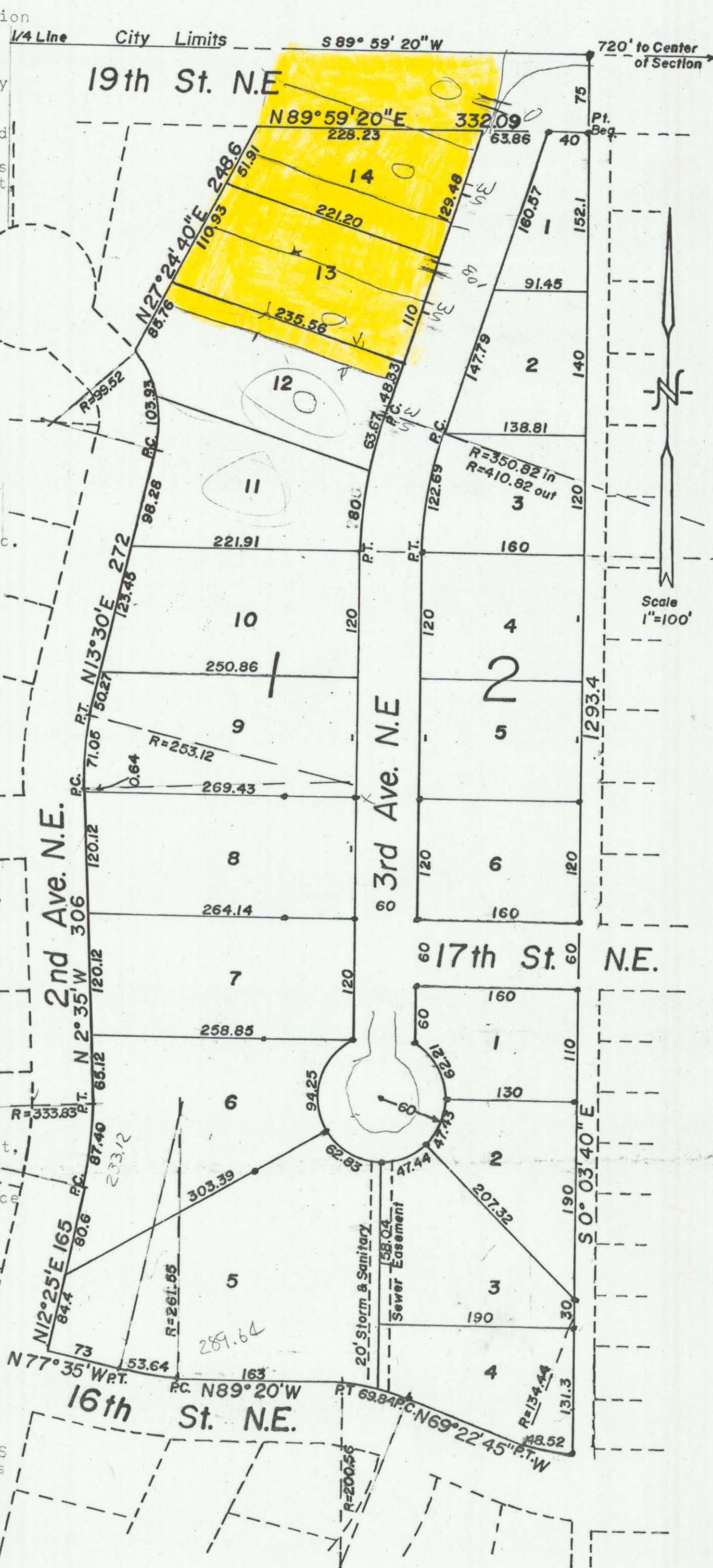
Beginning at a point 720 feet S 89° 59' 20" W and 75 feet S 0° 03' 40" E from the center of Section 24, T140N, R64W; hence S 0° 03' 40" W along the East line of what was Blocks 2 & 3 of WOODCREST ADDITION to the City of Jamestown, N. Dak. for a distance of 1293.4 feet, hence from a tangent bearing of S 89° 56' 20" W along a 43° 40' curve to the right for a distance of 48.52 feet, hence N 69° 22' 45" W for a distance of 123.95 feet, hence along a 28° 52' 21" curve to the left for a distance of 69.84 feet, hence S 89° 20' W for a distance of 163 feet, hence along a 22° 02' 32" curve to the right for a distance of 53.64 feet, hence N 77° 35' W for a distance of 73 feet, hence N 12° 25' E for a distance of 165 feet, hence along a 16° 13' 41" curve to the left for a distance of 87.40 feet, hence N 2° 35' W for a distance of 306 feet, hence along a 22° 47' 08" curve to the right for a distance of 71.05 feet, hence N 13° 30' E for a distance of 272 feet, hence along a 60° 19' 08" curve to the left for a distance of 103.93 feet, hence N 27° 24' 40" E for a distance of 248.6 feet, hence N 89° 59' 20" E for a distance of 332.09 feet to the point of beginning.
