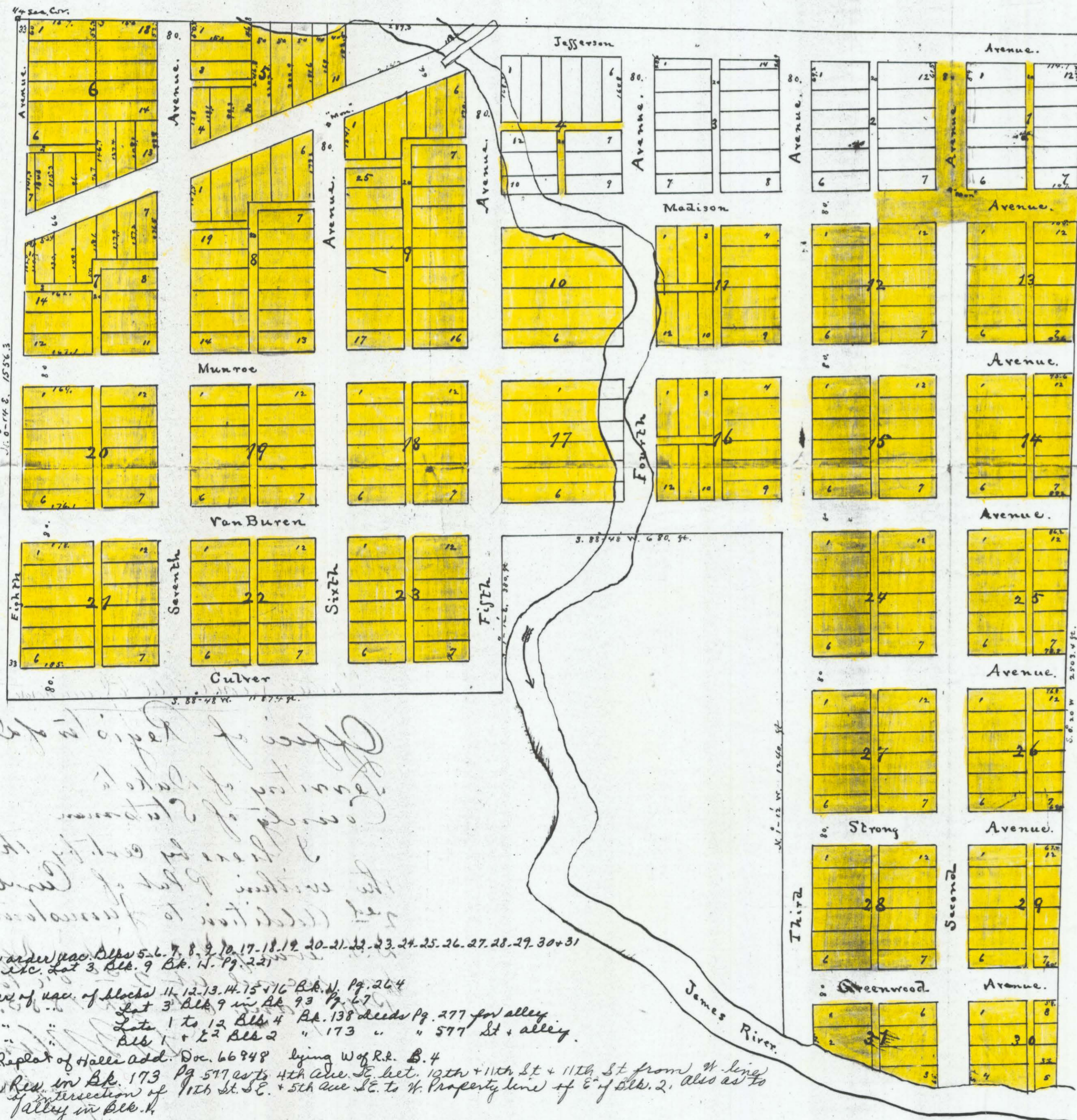


# CURTIN'S SECOND ADDITION TO JAMESTOWN D.T.

Curtin's Second Addition to Jamestown as here with platted is situated on the Southeast quarter (S.W. 1/4) of section 86 Township 140 Range 64, and is more particularly located as follows: Commencing at a point N 89° 25' W. 25.45 ft. from 1/4 Sec Corner on the East side of said section thence S. 2° 4' W. 250.34 ft. to the James River thence up the James River to the West line of 3rd Avenue thence N. 1° 12' W. 12.40 ft. Thence S. 98° 48' W. 680 feet. Thence S. 1° 12' E. 380 ft. Thence S 88° 48' W. 1187.4 ft. on a line Thence N. 0° 18' E. on section line. 1556.3 ft. Thence S. 89° 45' E. 2595 ft. to place of beginning.

All avenues here thru with right on them, all alleys are 20 ft. wide, all lots not otherwise noted on plat are 50 x 140 ft. monuments from which to make future surveys have been placed at the intersection of the north line of Madison Avenue with the center line of Second Avenue, also at the intersection of the center line of Fifth Avenue with the South line of Avenue, and this position noted on the plat thus: "a" with the word "Monument" placed contiguous thereto, and the Surveyor S.H. Foster hereby certifies that the accompanying plat was made by him from his notes of said survey and is with said survey correct and accurate to the best of his knowledge & belief.
