

Beginning at a point on the south line of the NW2 of Section 35, T140N, R64W, said point being the Southwesterly corner of Block 4, HOMESTEAD II, hence S 89° 29' E along said quarter line for a distance of 103.17 feet, hence from a tangent bearing of N 49° 59' E along a 23° 04' 26" curve to the right for a distance of 76.19 feet, hence N 16° 54' W along the east line of Lots 5 and 9, Block 4, HOMESTEAD II for a distance of 175.26 feet to the northerly boundary of said Block 4, hence from a tangent bearing of S 73 06' W along a 6 08' 31" curve to the left for a distance of 205 feet to the easterly line of 13th Ave. S.W., hence S 29° 29' E along said easterly line for a distance of IAA.22 feet to the point of beginning.
