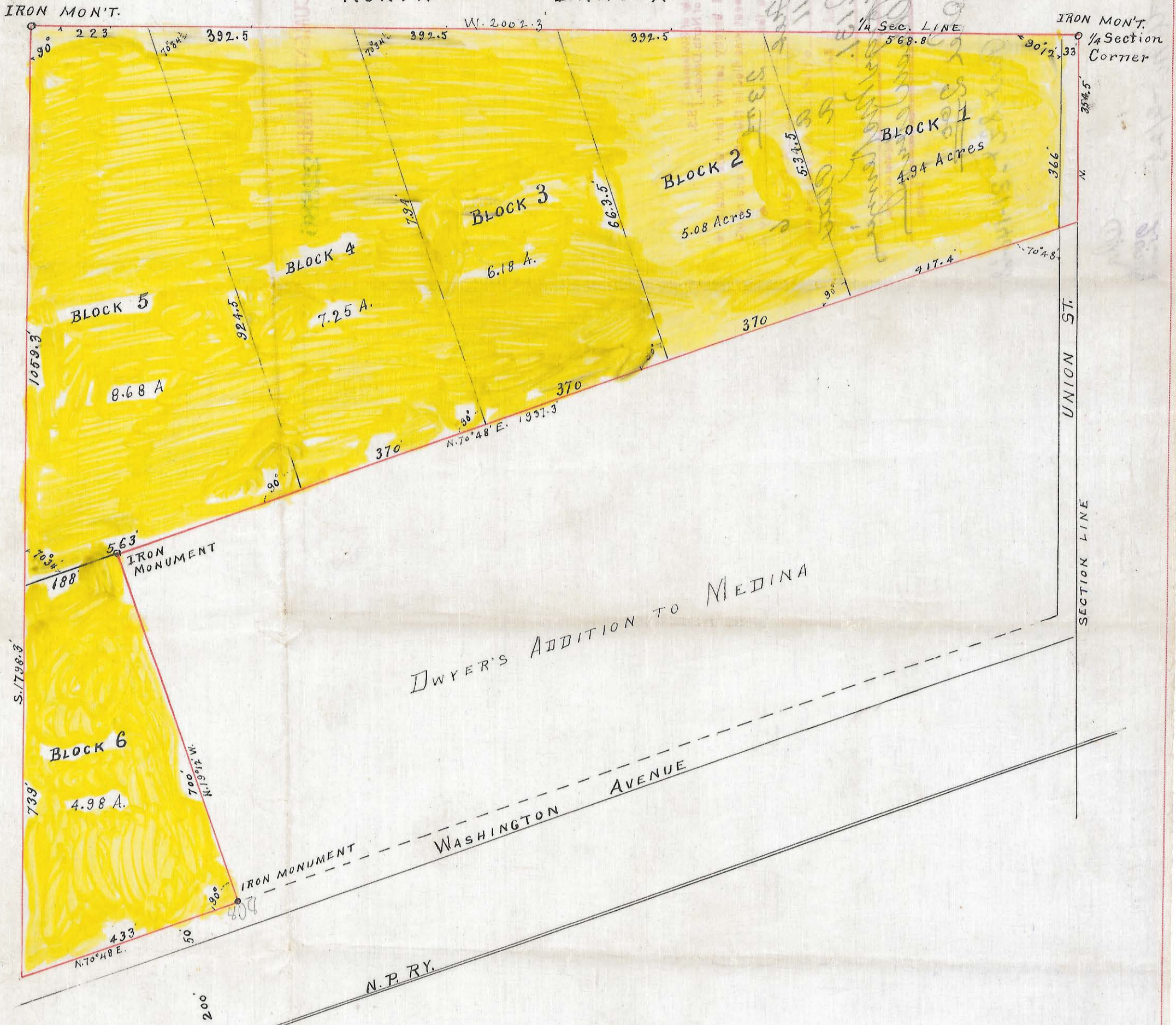


DWYER'S 2ND ADDITION TO MEDINA

Know all men by these presents, That Mary C. Dwyer and W. J. Dwyer her husband being owners and proprietors of a tract of land situated in the south east quarter of section thirty-one Township 140 Range 68 in Stutsman County, North Dakota, more particularly described as follows:—Commencing at the 1/4 Section corner on the east line of Section 31 T. 140 R. 68 Thence west on the 1/4 section line 2002.3 feet; Thence south 1798.3 feet; Thence N. 70° 48' E. 433 feet; Thence N. 19° 12' W. 700 feet; Thence N. 70° 48' E. 1937.3 feet; Thence North 354.5 feet to place of beginning containing 37.38 acres; have caused the same to be surveyed and platted in the manner shown on the annexed map as Dwyer's 2nd Addition to Medina, N. D. and do hereby dedicate and donate to the public use forever the streets and avenues therein shown.
