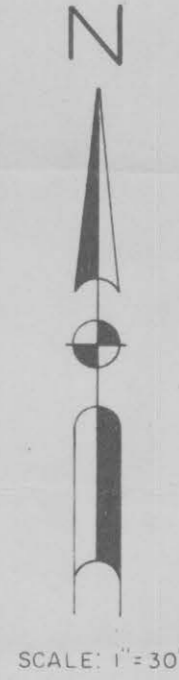
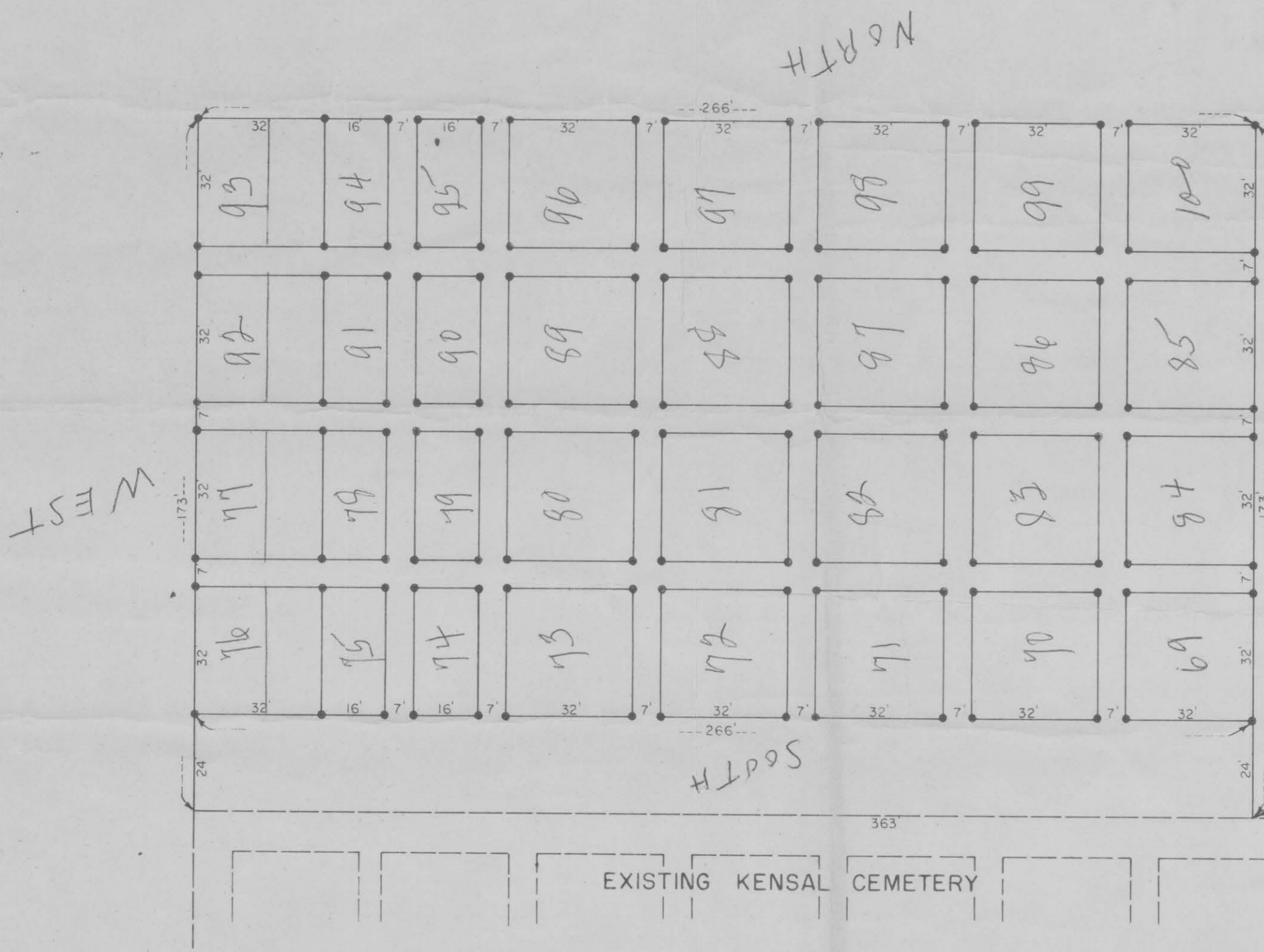

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the Kensal Cemetery Association of Kensal, North Dakota, a corporation, owners and proprietors of the property described as follows, to-wit:

A tract of land lying in the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$), in Section Eleven (11), Township One Hundred Forty Four (144), North, Range Sixty Four (64), West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, Stutsman County, North Dakota, said tract being bounded on the south side by the existing Kensal Cemetery, and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the section corner common to Section 11, 12, 13 and 14, T144N, R64W; thence North along the section line common to Sections 11 and 12, T144N, R64W, a distance of 359.5 feet to a point; thence west a distance of 130 feet to the point of beginning; thence North 173 feet to a point; thence west 266 feet to a point; thence South 173 feet to a point; thence East 266 feet to the point of beginning.
