KLAUS' THIRD ADDITION TO JAMESTOWN, DAK. TER..

Klaus' Third Addition to Jamestown, D.T. as herewith plotted, is situated in Stutsman County, on the Northwest quarter of Section 36, Town-ship 140, Range 64, and is further located as follows: Commencing at the quarter section post on the west boundary of said section, thence N 88-46 E 263.8 ft., thence S 1-10 E 1067.3 ft., thence S 89-44 W 264.65 ft. to place of beginning. The widths of all Avenues and their courses are noted on the plat. The alleys are parallel to all numbered avenues. All lots other than fractional are 140 x 50 feet, all different sized lots have their dimensions noted on the plat. Stones to serve as monuments have been placed at the intersection of the north line of Adams Avenue with the center line of Third and Sixth Avenues, and their positions noted on the plat thus X with the word "monument" placed contiguous thereto.

And the said surveyor Edward H. Foster, hereby certifies, that the survey of Klaus' third addition was made by him at the request of the proprietors thereof between the 3rd and 10th days of Nov. 1880. That the foregoing is a true and correct description of situation of town-site and of courses and length of boundary lines, and the accompanying plat was made by him from his notes of said survey and is correct and accurate to the best of his knowledge and belief.
