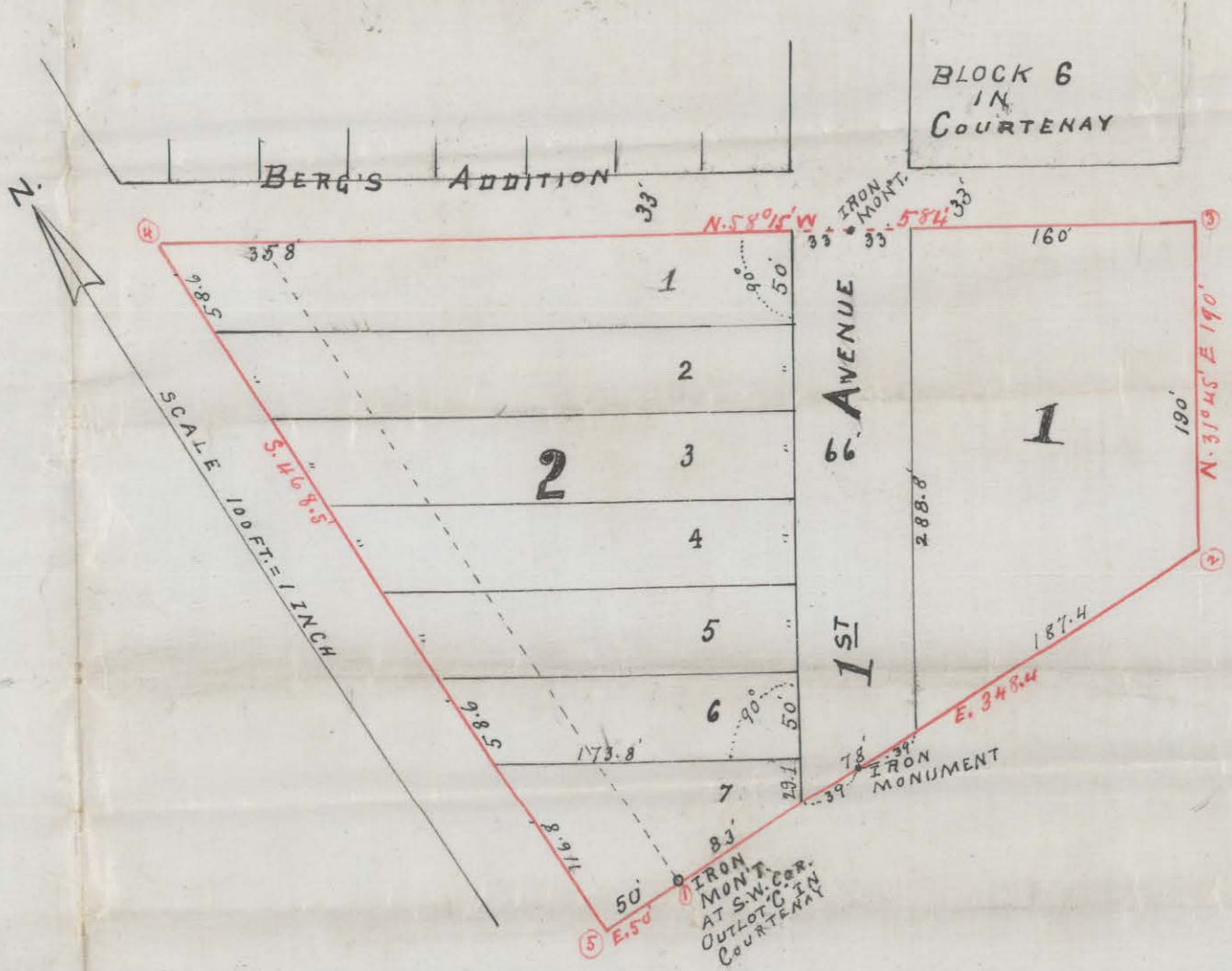


L. H. LARSON'S ADDITION TO COURTENAY. NORTH DAKOTA.

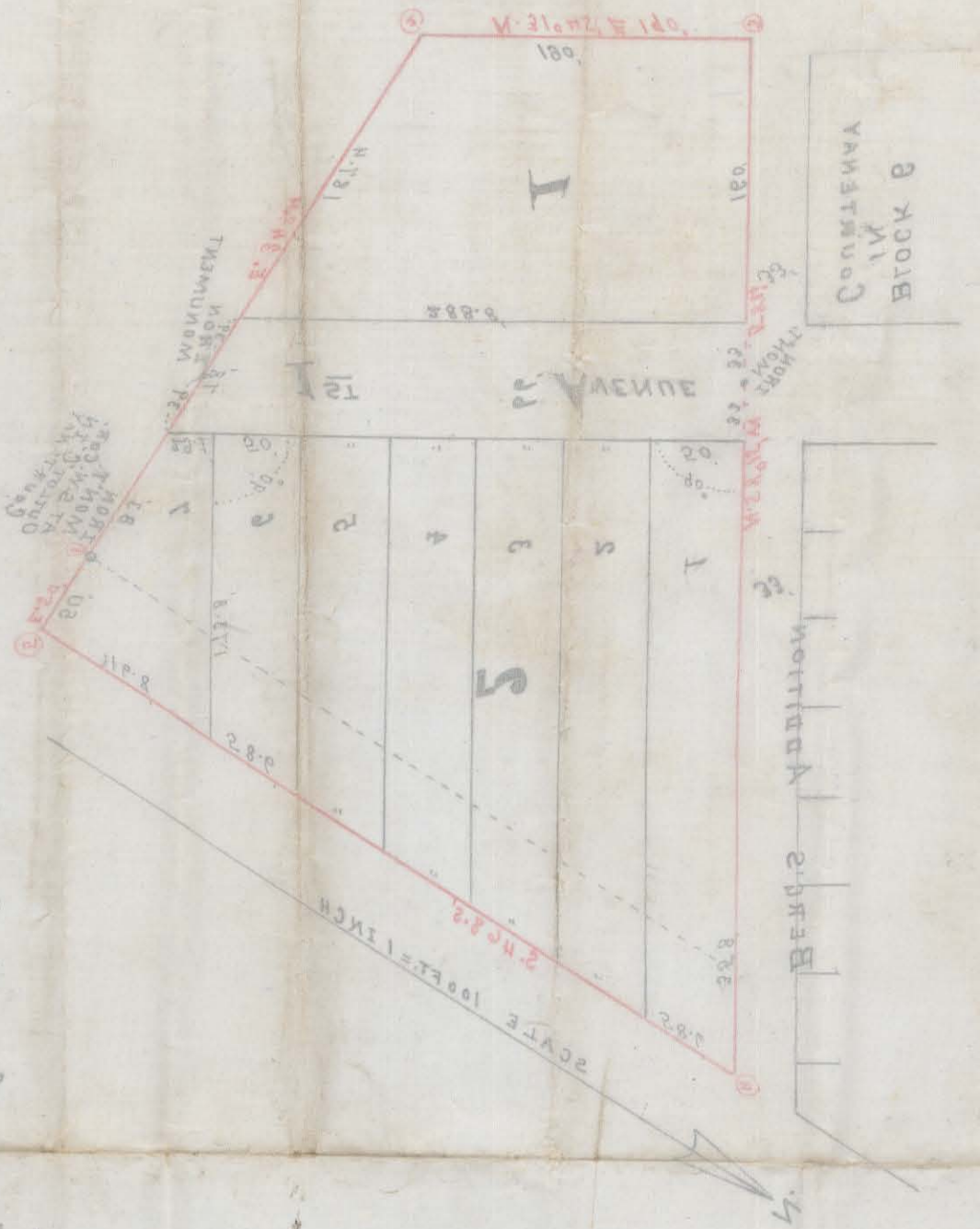
