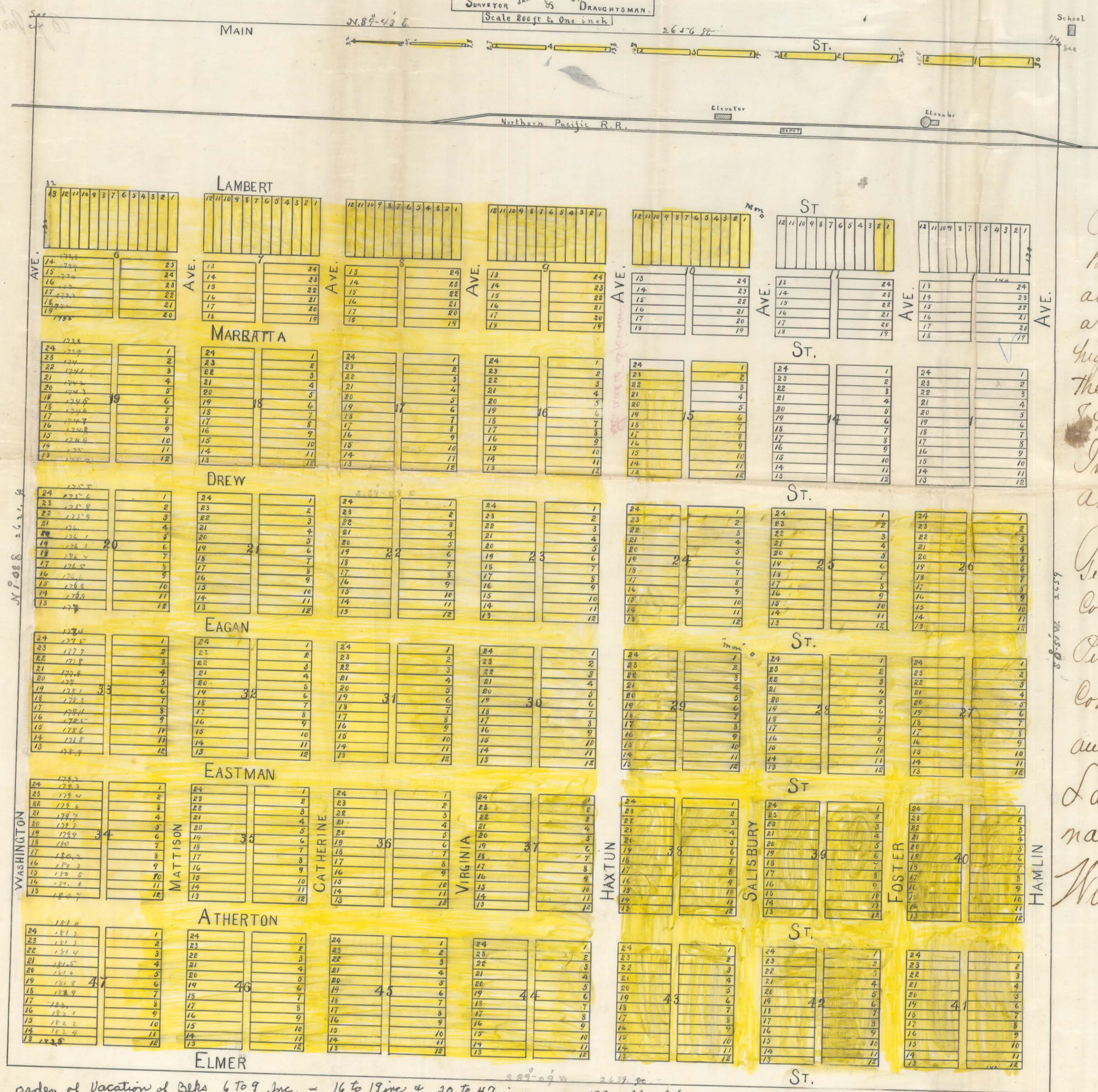


LAMBERT'S ADDITION TO SPIRITWOOD, STUTSMAN COUNTY, DAKOTA TERRITORY.

Lambert's Addition to Spiritwood Dakota Ter is located on the N.W. 1/4 of Section 22 Township 140 Range 62 in Stutsman County and Territory of Dakota and is further located as follows: Beginning at the N.W. corner of said Section 22 Thence N 89° 43' E 2656 ft 6 1/4 in corner thence S. 0° 57' W. 2654 ft. Thence S 89° 09' W. 2639 ft. Thence N 1° 08' E. 2621 ft. to place of beginning. All streets are 66 feet wide except main Washington which are 33 feet wide. All alleys are 20 feet wide, all lots not fractional are 140 feet deep, except those fronting on Lambert Street which are 130 feet deep, all lots are 25 feet wide except those west of Rail road track. Good and sufficient shows with marks on them, have been placed at the intersection of the center line of Salisbury street with the south lines of Lambert and Egan streets, to serve as monuments from which to make future surveys, and their positions noted on the plat thus "a" with the word Mon. placed contiguous thereto. The Surveyor Edward H. Foster hereby certifies that the survey of said addition, and the accompanying plat was made by him and are correct and accurate to the best of his knowledge and belief.
