Plat of Lubeck's First Addition to the City of Jamestown, North Dakota.
Elmer Lubeck as owner and proprietor of the land hereinafter described, together with Ross Milne, North Central Engineers, Registered Land Surveyor, in the State of North Dakota, hereby declare and make known that said owner and proprietor recently caused to be laid out, platted and surveyed, a plat of Lubeck's First fiddition to the City of Jamestown, North Dakota; and this plat thereof which is hereto attached was made by the said Ross Milne, in accordance with the statues of the State of North Dakota and ordinances of the City of Jamestown, North Dakota, in such case, made and provided, a description of the situation and boundaries of said Lubeck's First iddition being as follows:

That said plat is part of the Southwest One- uarter of section 31, 7140N, R63W and part of the Northwest one-Juarter of Section $6, \mathrm{Tl} 39 \mathrm{~N}, \mathrm{R} 63 \mathrm{~W}$, in Stutsman County, North Dakota, and is more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a point which is the intersection of the North South One-2uarter line of Section 31, M140N, R63W and the Southerly Right-0:- av of the Bast Business Loop of Interstate Highway \#94, thence North $63^{\circ}$ $56^{\prime} 47^{\prime \prime}$ West a distance of 1278.39 feet to a point, thence along a $2^{\circ} 5^{\prime} \quad 25^{\prime \prime}$ curve to the right a distance Of 253.4 feet to a point, thence North $63^{\circ} 45^{\prime}$, west a distance or 374.07 feet to a point, thence North $45^{\circ}$ $30^{\prime}$ West a distance of 289.8 feet to a point, thence North $90^{\circ} 00$ West a distance of 200 feet $\pm$ to a point which is the center of the James River, thence Southeasterly on the center line of the James River to a point on the center line of the Janis River which is 240 feet $\pm$ South of the point of beginning, and on the Worth South One- quarter line of section 31, M14011, R63W, thence North $0^{\circ} 29.521$ West along said one- quarter line a distance of 240 feet $\pm$ to the point of begininng. Said tract to contain 21.4 acres more or less.

That the foregoing is a true and accurate description of the situation and boundaries of said Lubeck's First Addition.
