

PLAT OF LUTHERAN CEMETERY  
STREETER, NORTH DAKOTA.

DESCRIPTION of lands in Lutheran Cemetery in S. E. 1/4 Section 22, Township 137 N., Range 69 W., described as follows:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of the Southeast quarter (SE 1/4) of Section Twenty two (22), Township One hundred thirty seven (137) North, Range Sixty nine (69) West and extend a line 519 feet west, then 179 feet south, then 519 feet east and 179 feet north to the beginning point.

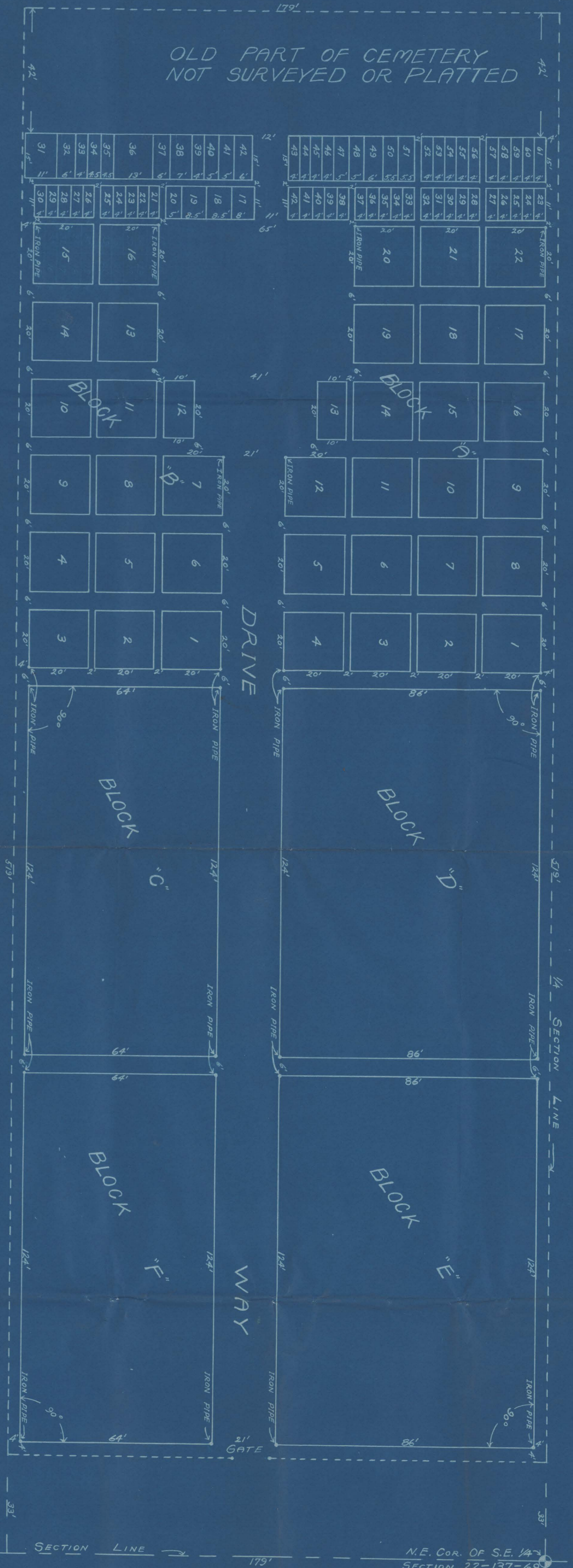
