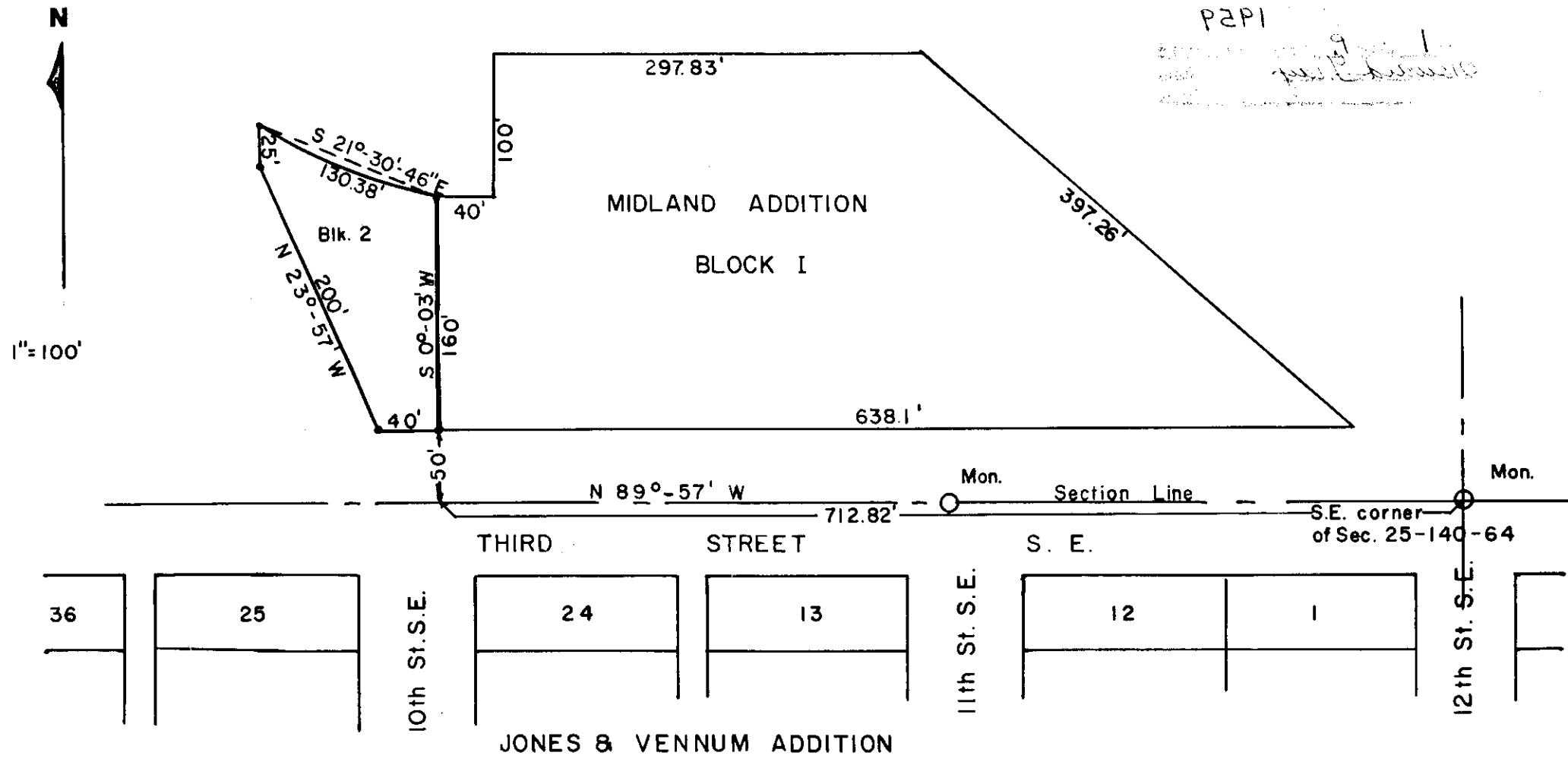

DECLARATION OF PLAT Plat of Midland 2nd Addition To the City of Jamestown, North Dakota

Midland Continental Railroad, (A North Dakota Corporation), with its place of business in the City of Jamestown, in Stutsman County, North Dakota, as owner and proprietor of land hereinafter described, together with Donald Wenaas, registered professional engineer and Surveyor, and as City Engineer of the City of Jamestown, North Dakota, hereby declare and make known that said owner and proprietor recently caused to be laid out and platted and surveyed, a plat of Midland 2nd Addition to the City of Jamestown, North Dakota; and this plat thereof which is hereby attached was made by the said Donald Wenaas of Jamestown, North Dakota, in accordance with the statutes of the State of North Dakota and Ordinances of the City of Jamestown, North Dakota, in such case made and provided, a description of the situation and boundaries of said Midland 2nd Addition being as follows, to-wit:

That said Plat is part of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of Section Twenty-Five (25) Township One Hundred Forty (140) North of Range Sixty-four (64) West of the Fifth (5th) principal meridian in Stutsman County, North Dakota, what was formerly known as part of Block Twenty (20) and the vacated street adjacent thereto of McGinnis Second Addition, consisting of .34 acres more or less, and is more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the Southeast corner of said quarter section; thence North 89°-57' West along section line between Sections 25-140-64 and 36-140-64 a distance of 712.82 feet; thence North 0°-03' East a distance of 50 feet to the point of beginning; thence North 89°-57' West a distance of 40 feet; thence North 23°-57' West a distance of 200 feet; thence North 0°-03' East a distance of 25 feet; thence South 21°-30'-46" East a distance of 130.38 feet; thence South 0°-03' West a distance of 160 feet to the point of beginning.

That the foregoing is a true and accurate description of the situation and boundaries of said Midland Second Addition.

The figures on the attached Plat representing the distances, length and breadth, denote feet or decimals thereof. No streets or alleys are included in this Plat.

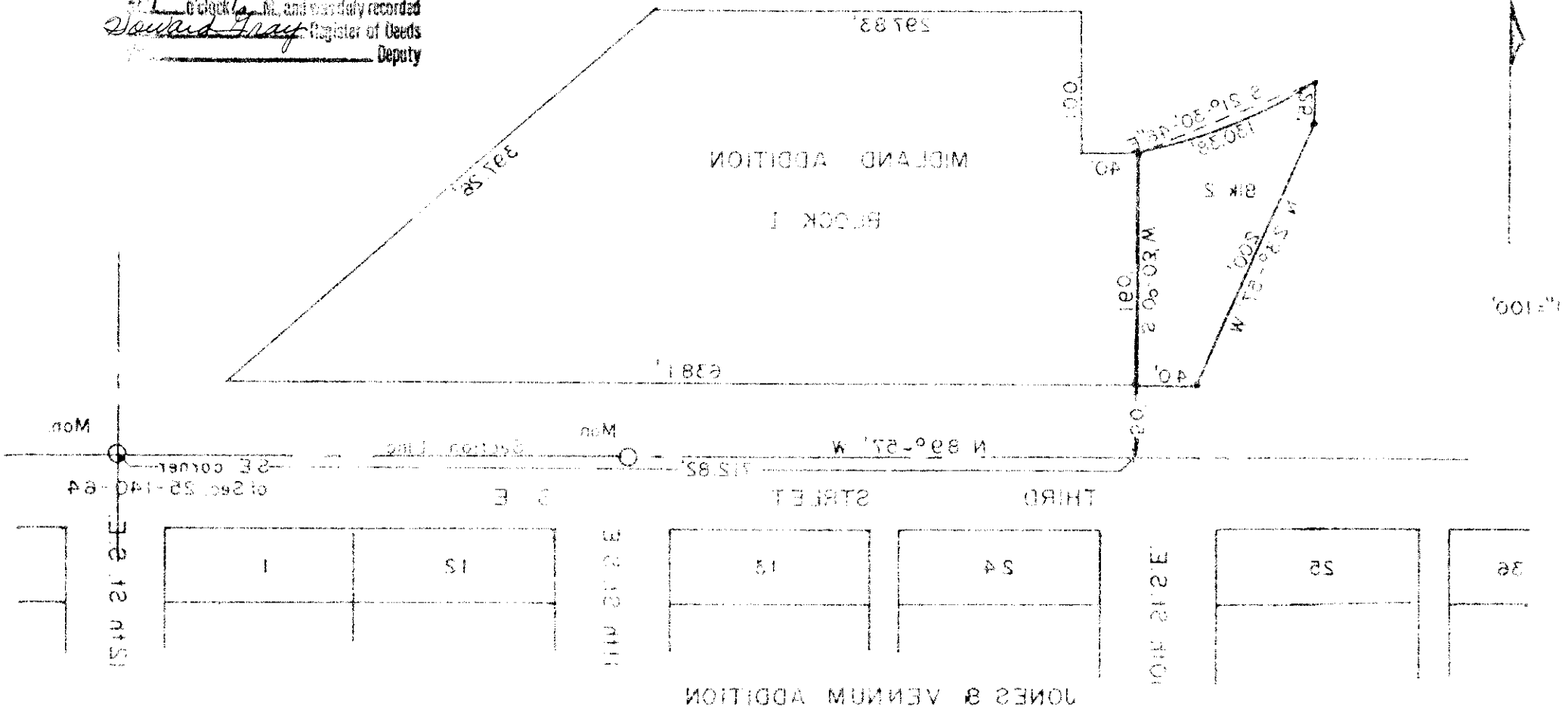

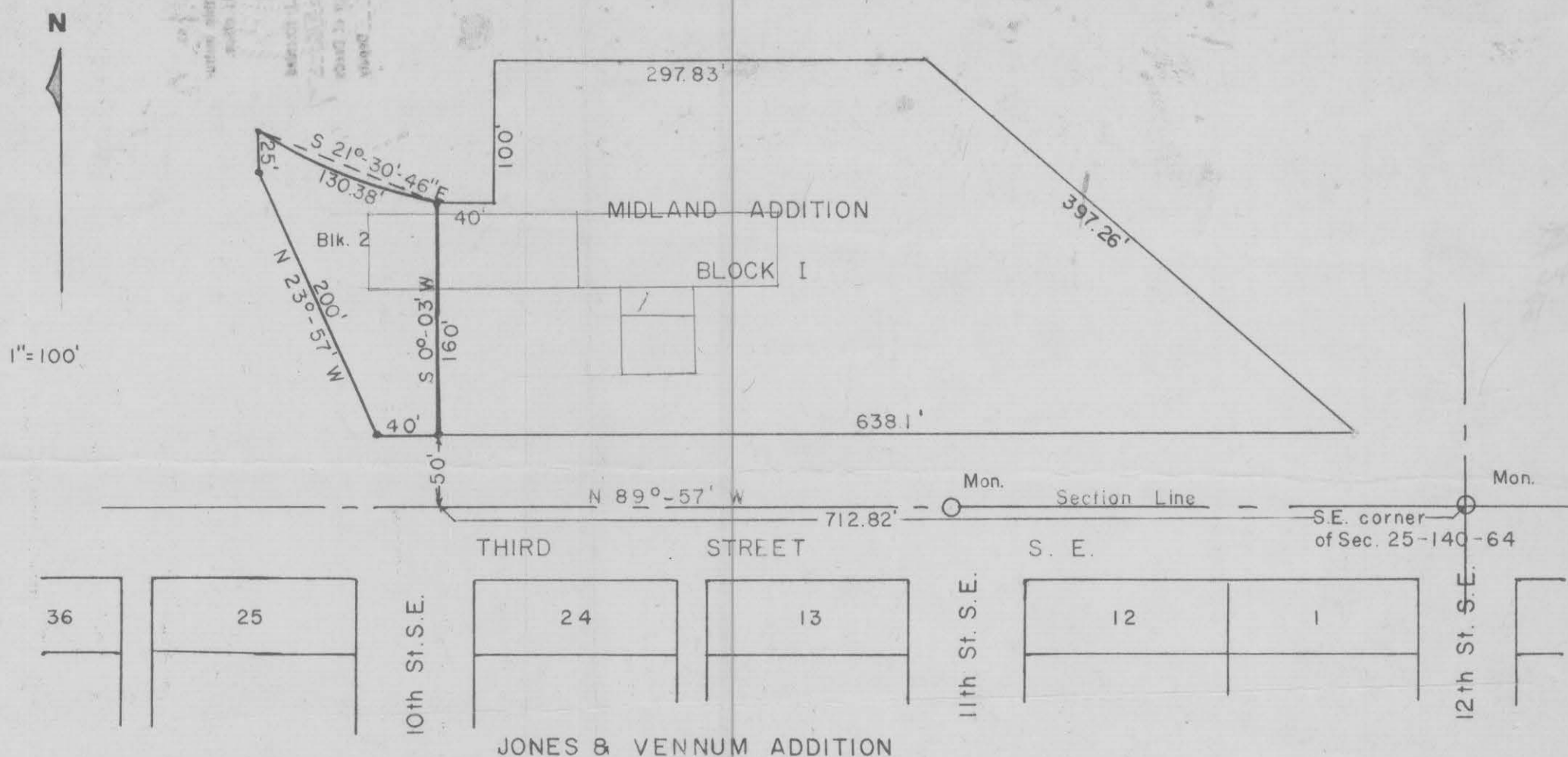

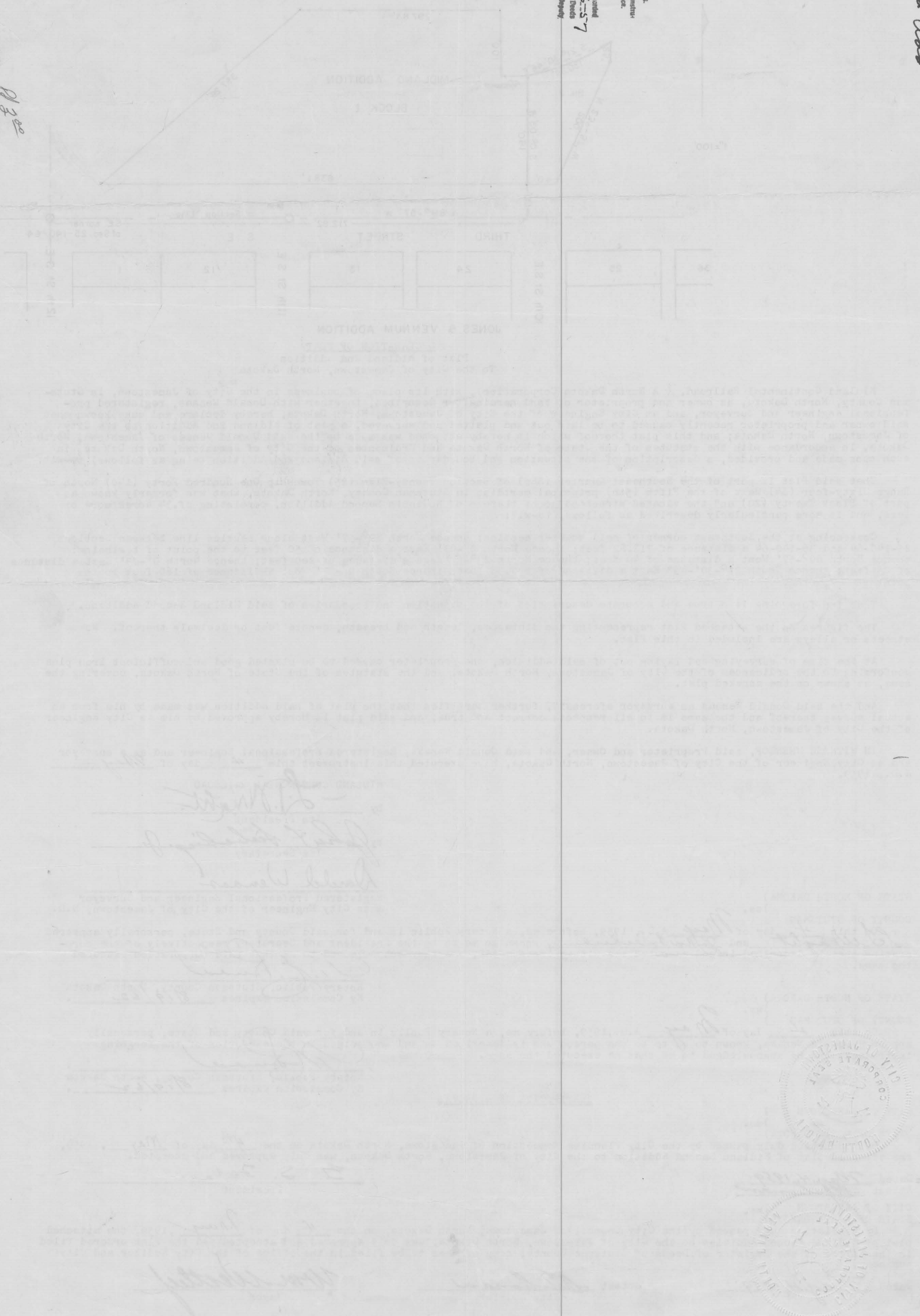
