The Catholic Cemetery near Montpelier, North Dakota, comprises part of the south-east one quarter of Section Two (2), Township One hundred thirty-seven (137) North, Range Sixty-three (63) West, described as follows;

Beginning at a point, which point is thirty-three (33) feet north and thirty-three (33) feet west of the southeast corner of Section Two (2), Township One hundred thirty-seven (137) North, Range sixty-three (63) West, thence north parallel to and thirty-three (33) feet, distant west of the east line of said Section Two, Three hundred thirty-six and ninety-eight hundredths (336.98) feet, thence west at an angle of eighty-nine degrees and fifty-three minutes (89° 53') to last described line One hundred twenty-nine and twenty-seven hundredths (129.27) feet, thence south at an angle of ninety degrees and seven minutes (90° 07') to last described line three hundred thirty-six and ninety-eight hundredths (336.98) feet to point thirty-three (33) feet north of the south line of said Section Two, thence east at an angle of eighty-nine degrees and fifty-three minutes (89° 53') to last described line, thirty-three (33) feet distant north of and parallel to the south line of said Section Two one hundred twenty-nine and twenty-seven hundredths (129.27) feet, to point of beginning. Tract comprising One (1) Acre.

St. Hubert's Cemetery Association, proprietor of said tract, and H.H. Furning, surveyor, hereby declare and make known that the said proprietor caused to be surveyed and laid out during the month of September 1931 and this plat to be made by said H. H. Furning, surveyor, according to the statute in such case provided. That the foregoing is a true and accurate description of the situation and boundaries of said Catholic Cemetery.

All the avenues or driveways and all lots are particularly described and set forth on the plat with numbers and dimensions. The figures representing dimensions or distances denote feet and decimals thereof. The proprietor's have caused to be set as shown on the plat, good and sufficient stone monuments. And the said H. H.
