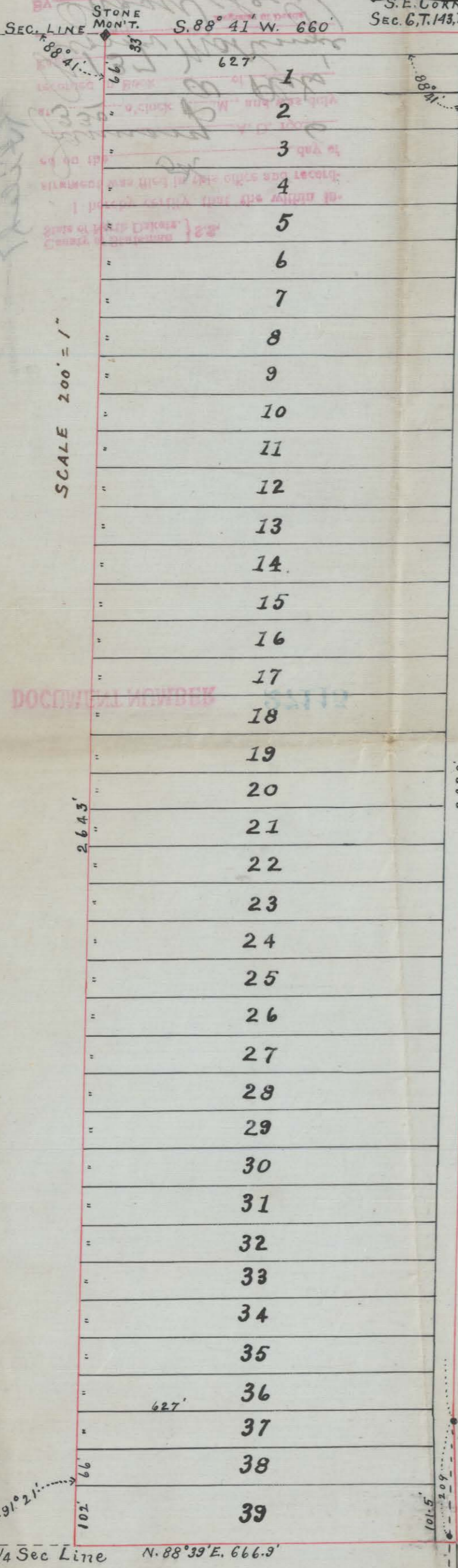


MURPHY'S **PARK.**

Know all men by these presents; That, I, H. J. Murphy being owner and proprietor of a tract of land situated in the North East quarter of section 7 Township 143 Range 62 in Stutsman County North Dakota more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the North East corner of said section 7 T. 143 R. 62 Thence South 88° 41' West along the section line 660 feet; Thence South 2642.5 feet; Thence N. 88° 39' E. 666.9 feet; Thence North along the section line 2642.5 feet to point of beginning containing 40.04 acres have caused the same to be surveyed and platted in the manner shown on the annexed map as Murphy's Park ~~Stutsman County, N.D.~~ and do hereby donate and dedicate to the public use forever all the streets and avenues thereon shown. 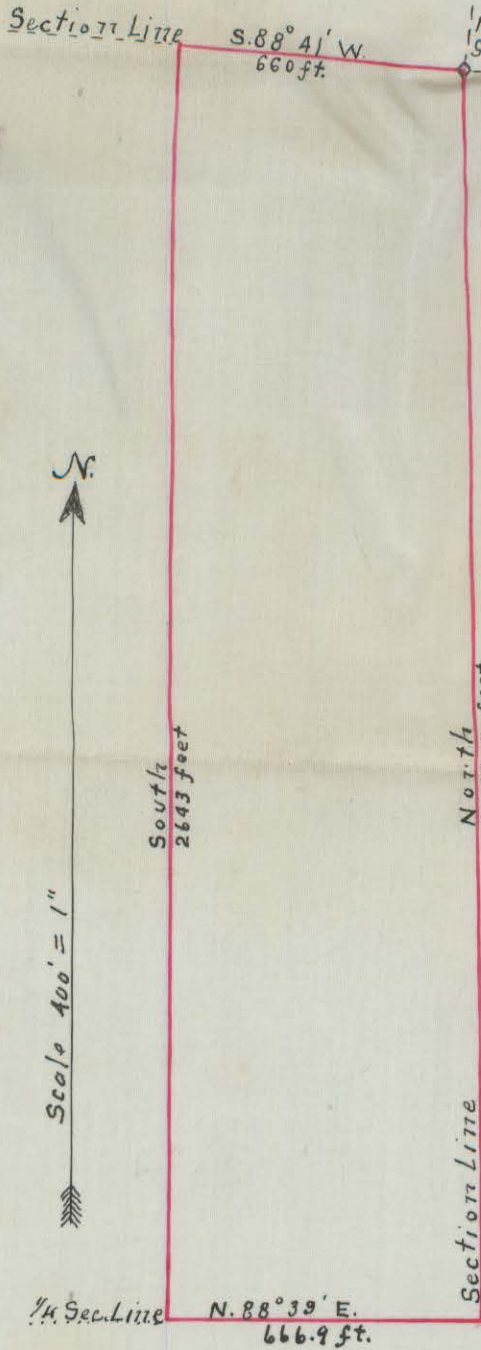
