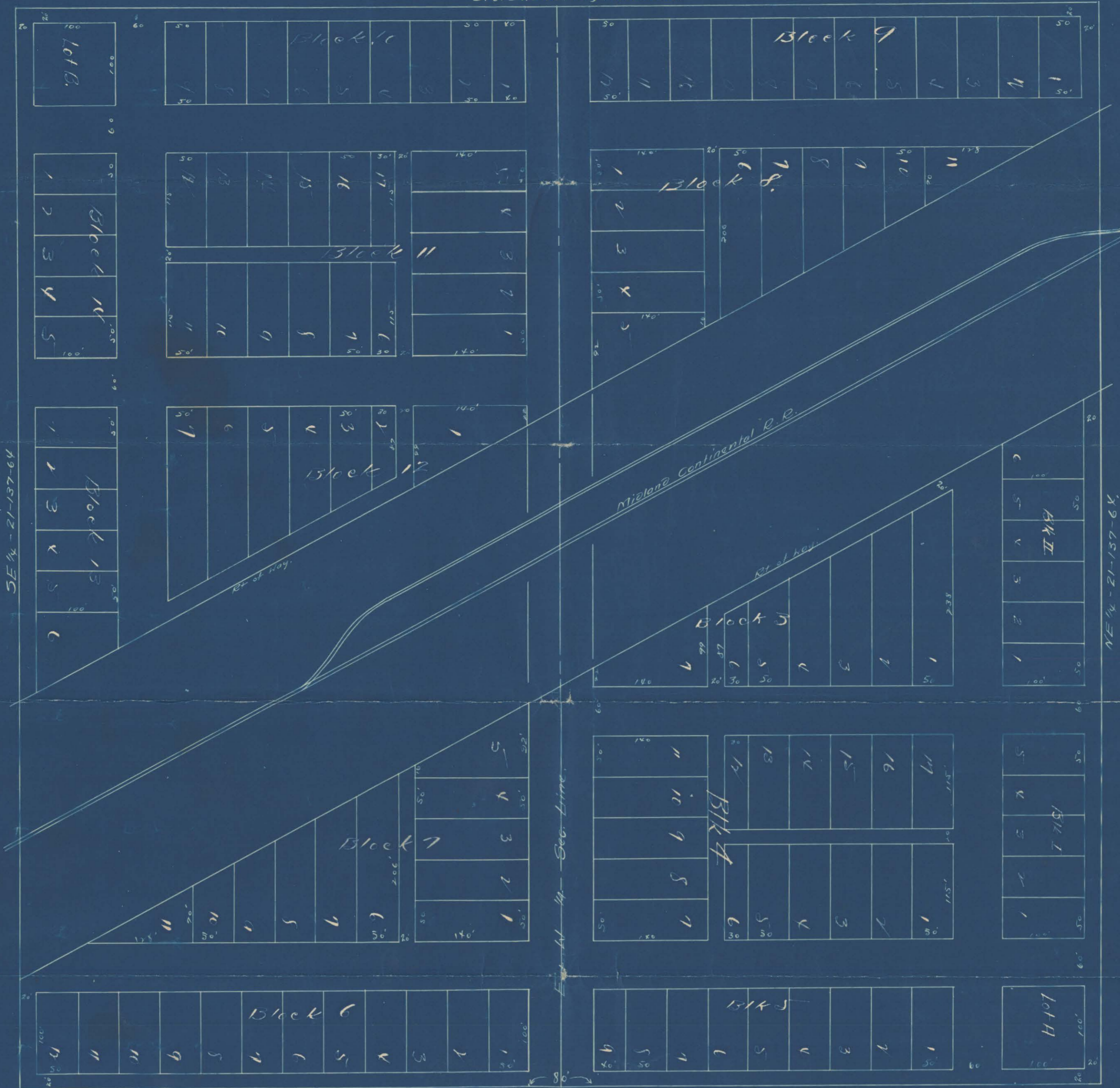


TOWNSITE OF MILLARTON.

Stutsman County, No. Dakota.



The townsite of Millarton as herewith platted, is situated on the (NE 1/4) Northeast Onequarter and the (SE 1/4) Southeast Onequarter of Section Twenty-one (21) Township One hundred thirty-seven (137) North, and Range Sixty-four (64) West. And is further described as follows: Commencing at a point in the south line of the Northeast one quarter of said Section 21, said point being five hundred twenty-four and nine tenths (524.9) feet west of the southeast corner of said NE 1/4 and running thence North at an angle of ninety (90) degrees with South line of said NE 1/4, a distance of six hundred and sixty (660) feet; thence due west parallel to and six hundred and sixty (660) feet from said South line of the NE 1/4 of Section 21, a distance of (1320) Thirteen hundred and twenty feet; thence due South a distance of (1320) Thirteen hundred and twenty feet; thence due east parallel to and six hundred and sixty feet from said South line of the NE 1/4 of Section 21-137-64, a distance of (1320) thirteen hundred and twenty feet; thence due North six hundred and sixty (660) feet to the point of beginning. Said place or parcel containing Forty (40) acres, more or less, inclusive of Right of Way of the Midland Continental Rail Road as now located, established and staked out across said Section Twenty One - (21-137-64).

The width of streets and avenues is as noted on map. All alleys are Twenty Feet (20) wide. All lots are (50) fifty feet and 100 or 140 feet deep. The dimensions of all fractional lots are indicated on the plat. All measurements are given in feet and tenths of feet 2" x 2" wooden stakes with indented tack denoting exact point at corners of all lots.

I hereby certify that the survey of the townsite of Millarton is correct to the best of my knowledge, information and belief.

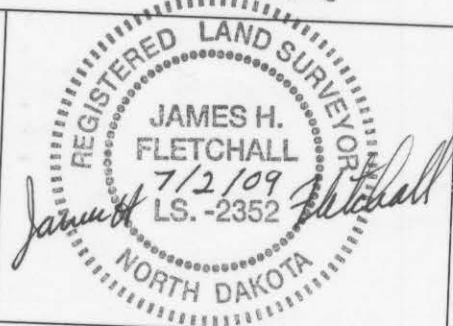
