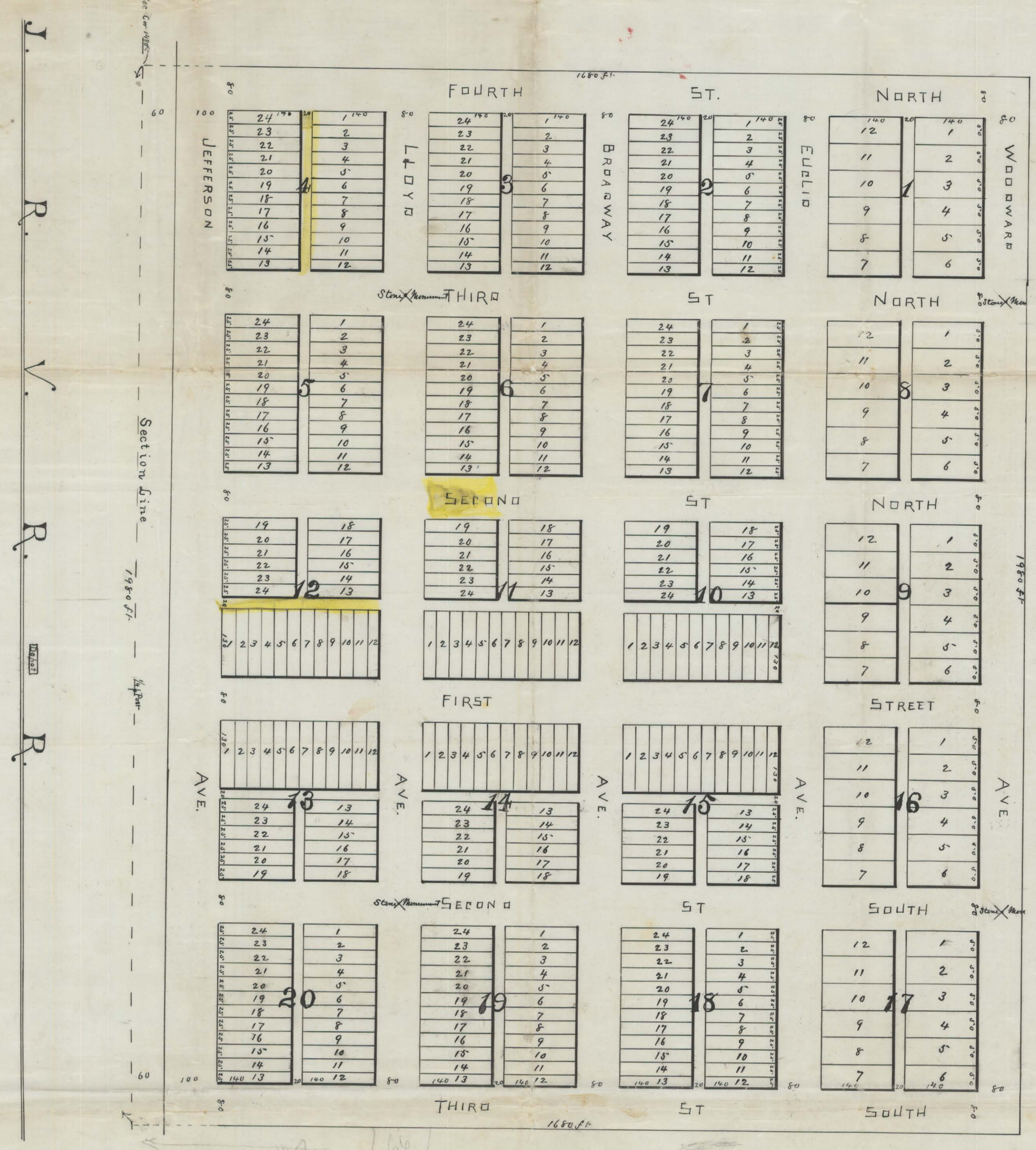


MAP OF YPSILANTI.

The Town of Ypsilanti as herewith platted is situated on the west half of Sec No 7 Township No 138 north of Range No 62 west of the 5th principal Meridian and is more particularly described as follows. Commencing at a point on the sec line on the west side of said sec No 7 and 1480 feet distant from the north west corner of said sec No 7. Thence south along the section line on the west side of sec No 7 for a distance of 1980 feet. Thence easterly at right angles to the last named course for a distance of 1680 feet. Thence northerly at right angles to the last named and parallel to the sec line on the west side of said sec No 7 for a distance of 1980 feet. Thence westerly at right angles to the last named course for a distance of 1680 feet to the place of beginning. The streets and avenues are all 80 feet wide except Jefferson Ave which is 100 ft wide. The alleys are all 20 feet wide. The Blocks are numbered in progressive ratio from 1 to 20 inclusive. The numbers of the lots are shown at or near their centers. The dimensions of the lots are shown at or near their boundaries. Stone monuments are placed one foot under ground where they are shown on the plat All of which I certify to be correct
