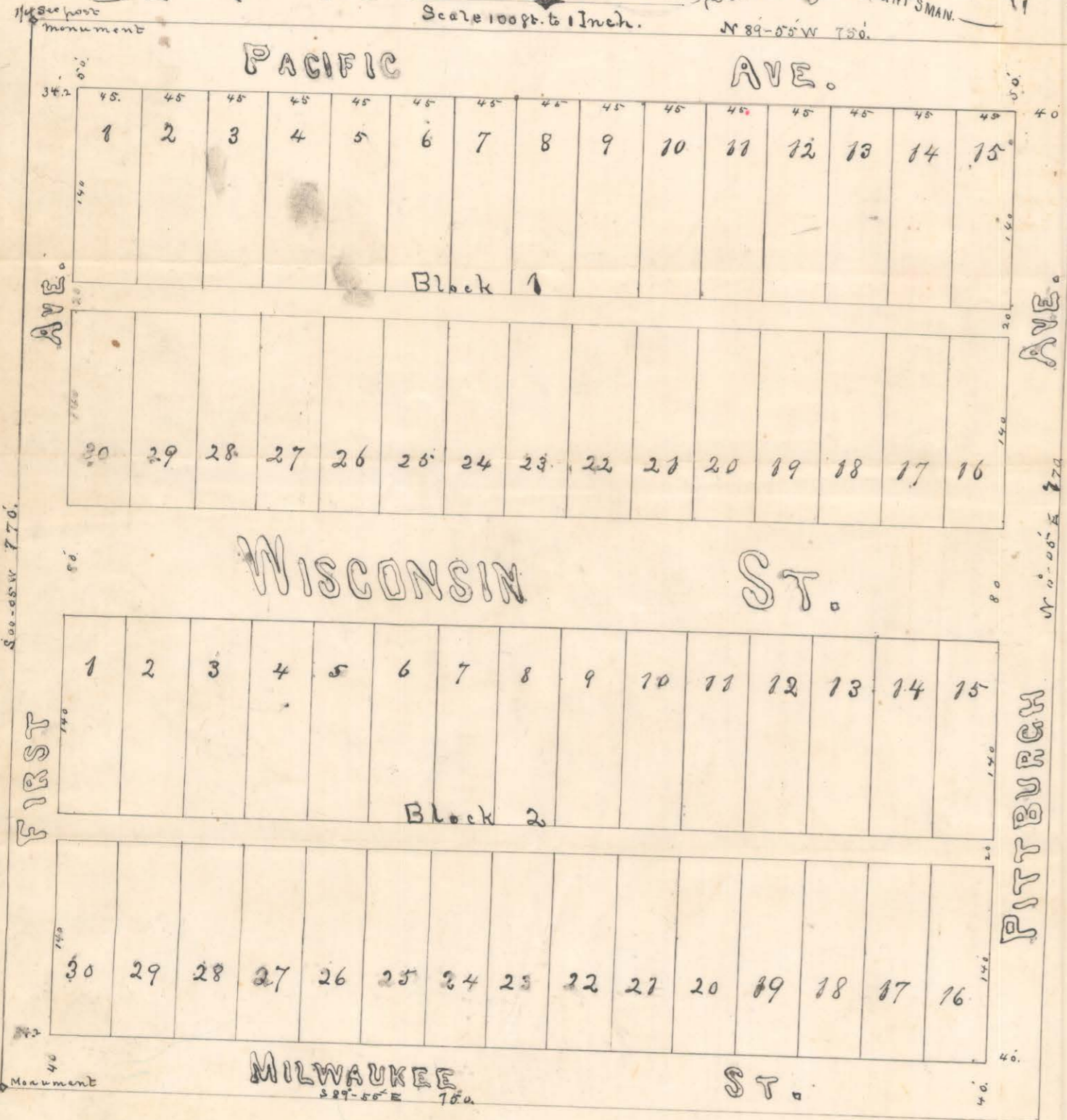
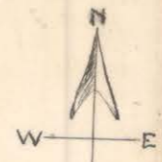


PANNELL & TILESTON'S ADDITION TO JAMESTOWN

Pannell & Tileston's Addition to Jamestown, D.T. as herewith platted, is situated at the N.W. corner of the N.W. 1/4 of the N.E. 1/4 of Section 36, Township 140, Range 64, and further located as follows:
Commencing at the monument placed at the 1/4 section corner at the north side of said section, thence S 89-05' W 770 feet; thence S 89-05' E 750 feet; thence N 0-05' E 770 feet; thence N 89-05' W 750 feet to place of beginning.
The widths of all Streets, Avenues, Alleys and lots are noted on the plat, also the lengths of all lots, in feet and decimals of a foot. Good and sufficient stones to serve as monuments from which to make future surveys, have been placed at the North West and South West corners of said addition, and their positions noted on the plat, thus "o" with the word "monument" placed contiguous thereto. And the surveyor Edward H. Foster hereby certifies, that he made the survey of the aforesaid addition, on the 4th day of August, A.D. 1881 at the request of the proprietors thereof; that foregoing is a correct description of location, courses, distances of boundaries, highways and of dimensions of lots; and that the accompanying plat was made by him, from his notes of said survey, and is accurate and correct, to the best of his knowledge and belief.
