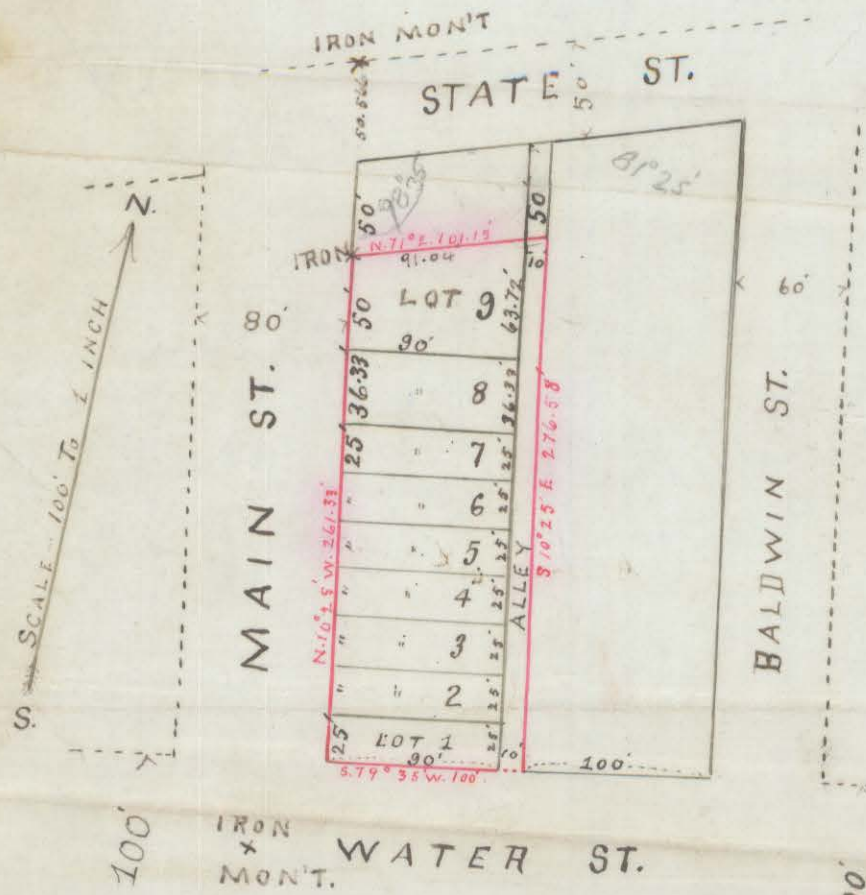


PARK ADDITION  
TO  
MEDINA, N. DAK.



I, Mary C. Dwyer, owner and proprietor of a tract of land situated and being in St. Anthony Park in the original town plat of Medina, in Stutsman County, North Dakota, more particularly described as follows:— Commencing at the South West corner of St. Anthony Park, being a point at the intersection of the north line of Water Street with the East line of Main Street in said town of Medina, N. D. Thence North  $10^{\circ}25'$  West along the east side of Main Street 261.33 feet; Thence North  $71^{\circ}$  East 101.15 feet; Thence South  $10^{\circ}25'$  East 276.58 feet to north line of Water Street; Thence South  $79^{\circ}35'$  West along the north line of Water Street 100 feet to place of beginning; have caused the same to be surveyed and platted in the manner shown on the annexed map as Park Addition to Medina, N. D. and I do hereby donate and dedicate to the public use forever the alley thereon shown.
