

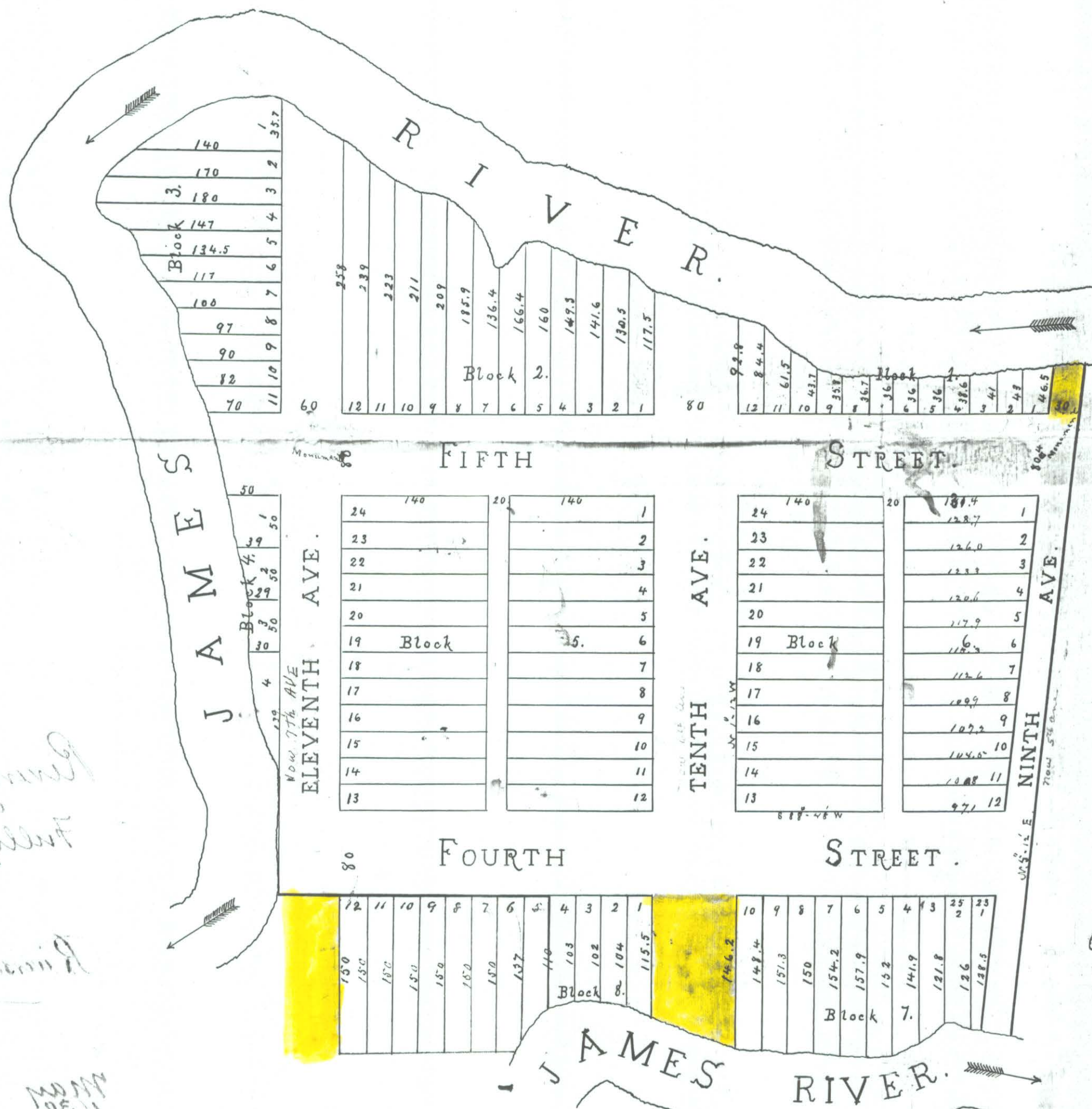
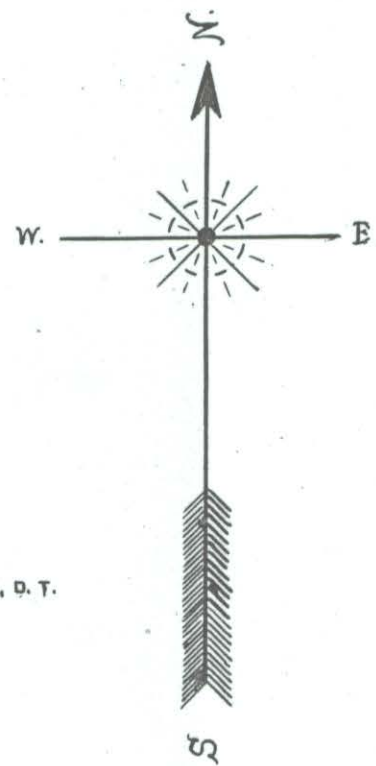
PLAT OF RIVERSIDE ADDITION

Riverside Addition to Jamestown, Stutsman County, Dakota Terr., as herewith platted is situated on Lot 13 of Section 26, T. 140, Range 64, of 5th Principal Meridian, and is further located Beginning at the NW corner between Sections 26 & 27 of said township, & range. Thence South on section line & center of Eighth Avenue 350.6 ft. to center of Fifth Street thence along said center of Fifth Street 380.4 ft. to center of Ninth Avenue, or 280.6 to monument at West side of said Avenue. The course of the Streets is 88° 40' N. of 10th & 11th avenues and of the alley is N 71° 12' W. of 9th Avenue to N 5° 12' E. All full lots are 25 ft wide except where otherwise noted on the plat. and 140 ft deep except where otherwise noted. Good & sufficient stones for monuments have been placed at intersection of center line of Fifth Street with West line of Ninth and East line of Eleventh Avenue, to serve as monuments from which to make future surveys as provided by law and their position noted on the plat thus "o" with the word "monument" placed contiguous thereto. And the Surveyor, Edward H. Foster, hereby certifies that the accompanying plat was made under his direction from his notes of said survey and is with the survey, accurate and correct to the best of his knowledge & belief.
