

## ST. JAMES FIRST ADDITION TO CALVARY CEMETERY THE NORTHERLY PORTION OF BLOCK 16 SOUTHWOOD SECOND ADDITION TO THE CITY OF JAMESTOWN, NORTH DAKOTA
