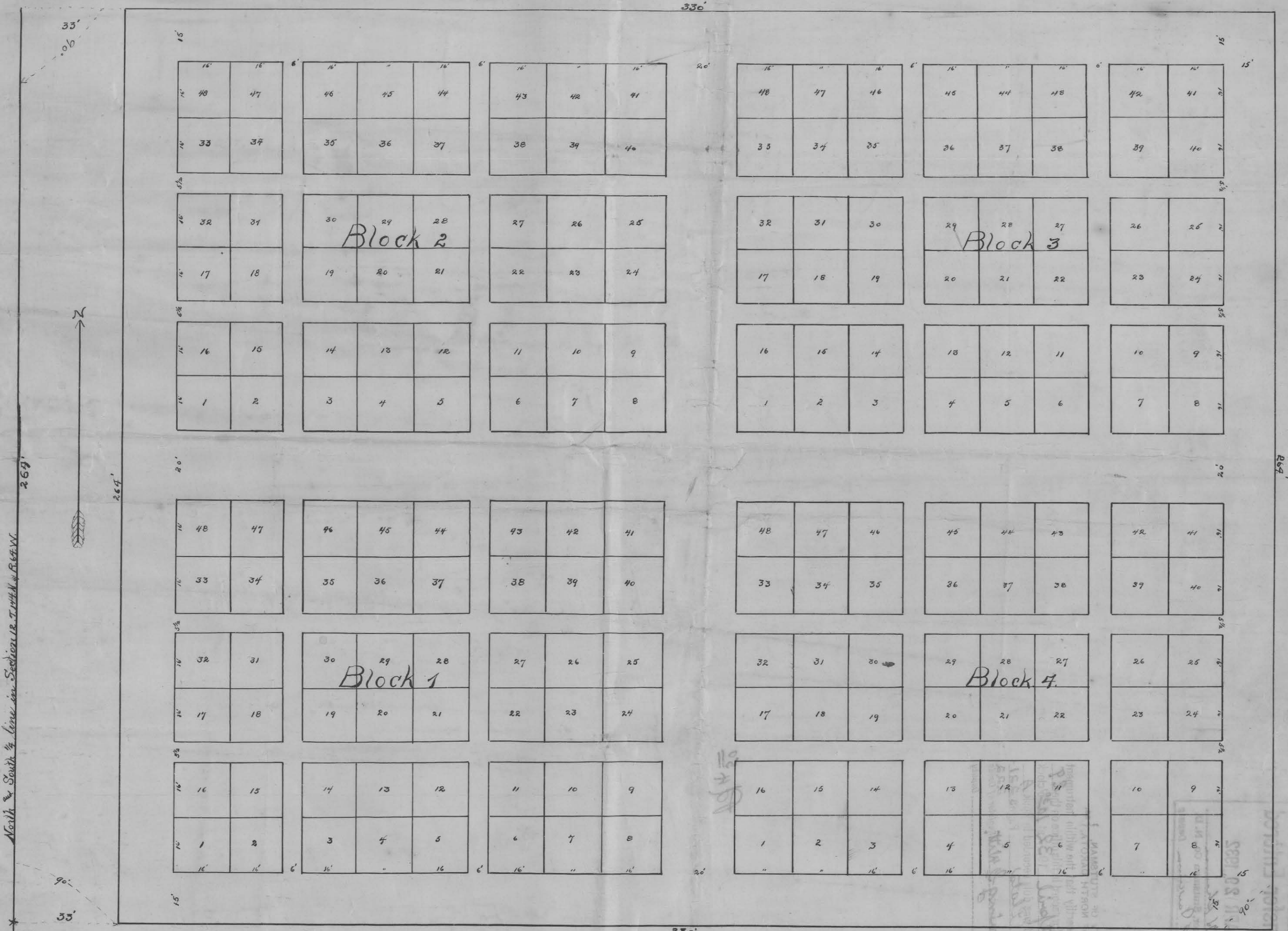


# Cemetery

## ST JOHN'S AT KENSAL, N.D.



Description of Above Plat, is as follows, to-wit: Two Acres of Land lying  $\frac{1}{4}$  being in the South West  $\frac{1}{4}$  Quarter of the North East  $\frac{1}{4}$  Quarter of Section 12 T.144.N. of Range 64.W. in Stutsman County, N.D., the place of beginning of the said two acre lot, is as follows, commencing at a point on the North  $\frac{1}{4}$  South Quarter line of the said Section 12, said point being Eight hundred eighty six  $\frac{1}{100}$  (886.6) feet North of an Iron Monument located at the Center of the aforesaid Section 12 T.144.N. of Range 64.W. Thence at right angles to said  $\frac{1}{4}$  Quarter line in an Easterly direction a distance of 33' feet to a point said point is the South West Corner of Cemetery lot; Thence East on same line a distance of (330') feet to the South-East Corner of said lot; Thence 90° angle from said line North 264' feet to North-East Corner of said lot; Thence 90° angle from said line West a distance of 330' feet to the North-West corner of said lot; Thence 90° angle from said line South to South West Corner of said lot said South-West Corner being 33' East of the North  $\frac{1}{4}$  South Quarter line of S. 12. T. 144. N. R. 64. W.
