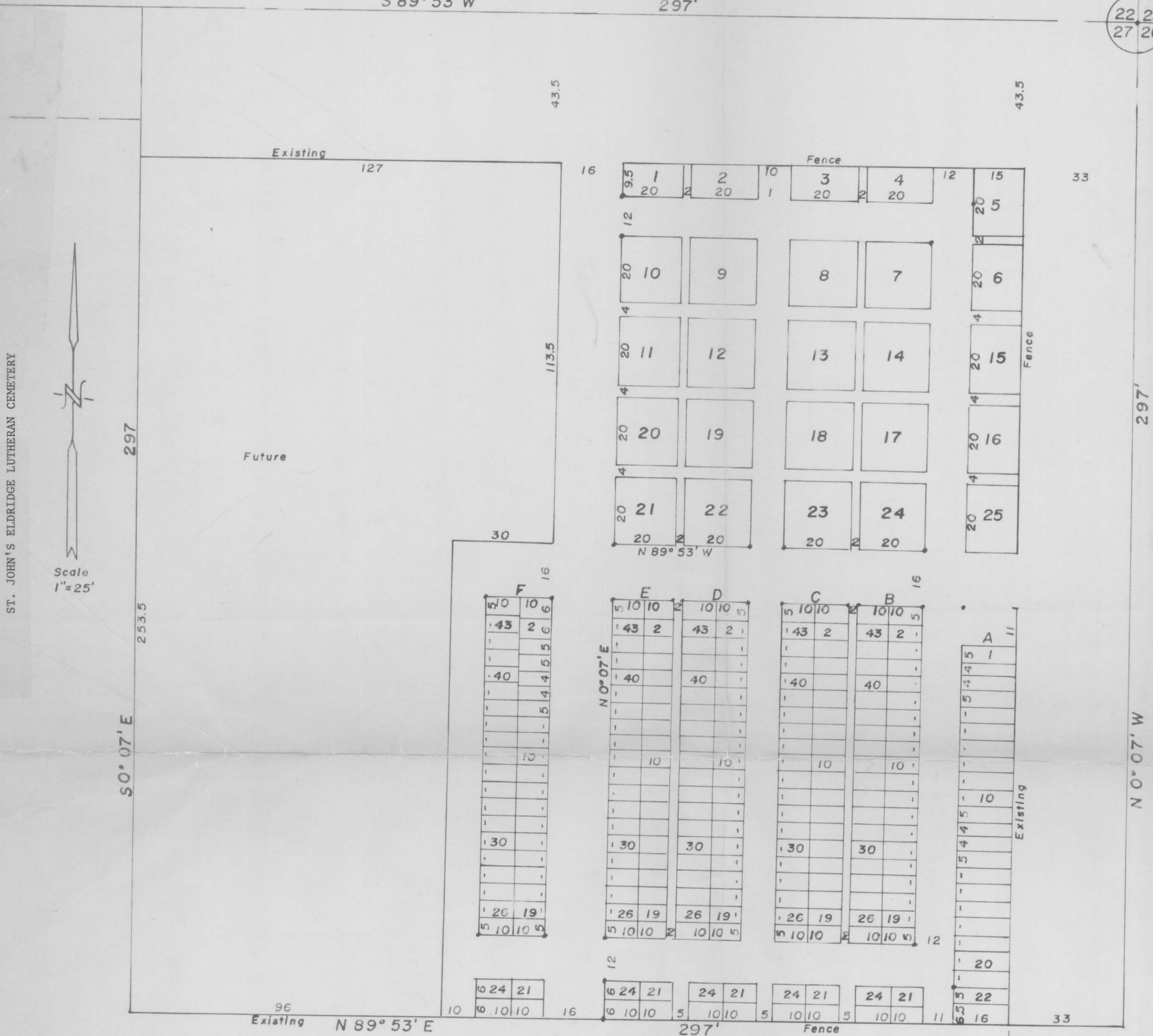

SURVEYORS CERTIFICATE:

I, Donald Wenasas, a Registered Professional Engineer and Land Surveyor in the State of North Dakota, hereby declare and make known that the attached plat of ST. JOHN'S ELDRIDGE LUTHERAN CEMETERY is in the Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4) of Section Twenty Seven (27), Township One Hundred and Forty North (T140N) of Range Sixty Five West (R65W), in Stutsman County, North Dakota, and is more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of said Section 27, thence running Westerly along the North line of said Section for a distance of Eighteen (18) rods, thence South parallel with the East line of said Section a distance of Eighteen (18) rods, thence East parallel with the North line of said section a distance of Eighteen (18) rods to the East line of said Section, hence North along said East line a distance of Eighteen (18) rods to the point of beginning, containing two and one fortieth acres, more or less.

I further certify that this plat of ST. JOHN'S ELDRIDGE LUTHERAN CEMETERY was made by me from an accurate survey thereof and is correct and true to the best of my knowledge. The figures representing lengths, breadths, and distances denote feet and decimal fractions thereof.
