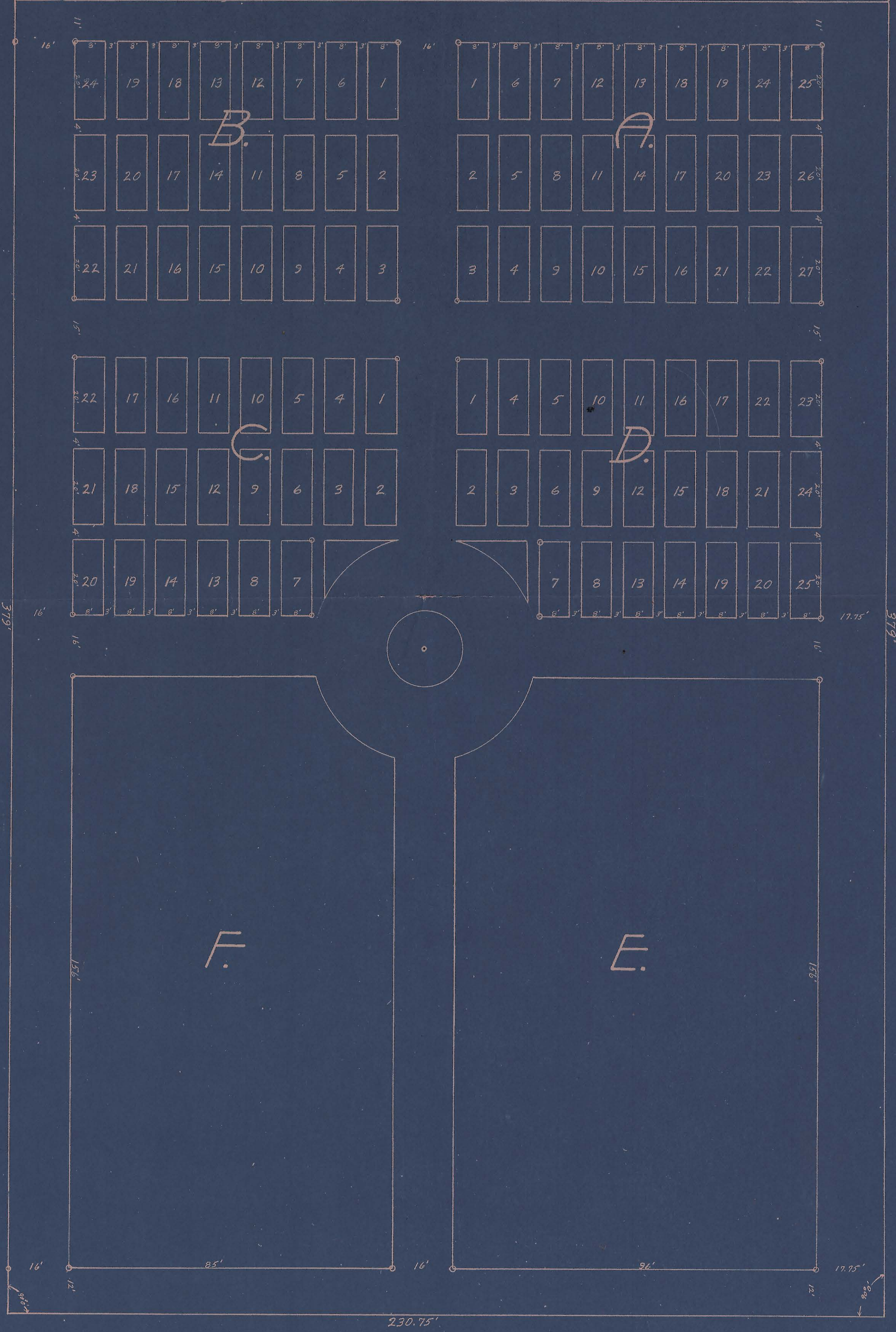

Description of lands in Saint Margaret's Cemetery in Section 5-141-64, described as follows. Commencing at a point 875.75 feet east of the Northwest corner of Section five (5) in Township one hundred forty one (141), North, of Range sixty four (64), West; thence easterly along the northerly boundary line of said section 230.75 feet; thence southerly and at right angles with the line last described, 379 feet; thence westerly and at right angles with the line last described 230.75 feet; thence northerly and at right angles with the line last described 379 feet, or to the place of beginning, containing 2 acres more or less.

DEDICATION. BE IT KNOWN, that the undersigned, Trustees for and proprietors of the Saint Margaret's Cemetery of Buchanan, North Dakota, have caused the survey and plat to be made of the Saint Margaret's Cemetery, and they do hereby dedicate the platted lands to the use of burying the dead, and the avenues or driveways and all lots are particularly described and set forth on the plat with numbers and dimensions. The figures representing dimensions or distances denote feet and decimals thereof, and as shown on the plat are in all respects, correct and true.

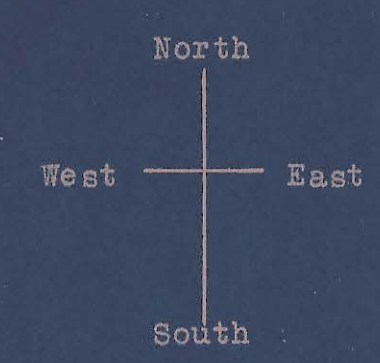
