CERTIFICATE OF DEDICATION.

Be it known, that ST. MATHIAS CHURCH, a North Dakota Corporation, of Windsor, N. D., being the owner and proprietor of a tract of land situated in the SE 1/4 of Section 33, Township 140 North, Range 66 West, in Stutsman County, North Dakota, said tract being more particularly described as follows; Beginning at a point 33 feet North and 33 feet West of the Southeast corner of Section 32-140-66, and running thence West along the North line of the highway on the South line of said Section 33 a distance of 330 feet, thence due North a distance of 267 feet, thence East parallel to the first described line a distance of 330 feet, thence due South a distance of 267 feet to the point of beginning, said piece or parcel containing two and two one hundredths (2.02) acres, more or less, all as shown on the annexed plat, - and has caused the same to be surveyed and platted as ST. PAULINE CEMETARY and hereby donates and dedicates to the public use forever all the avenues, streets and alleys as shown on the annexed plat, subject however to such rules and regulations as the said Corporation may make and prescribe for the proper care and protection of same. All Lots are 12 by 14 feet, all alleys are 4 feet wide, all streets and avenues are of the width shown on the plat. Lot and Block Numbers are as designated on plat.
