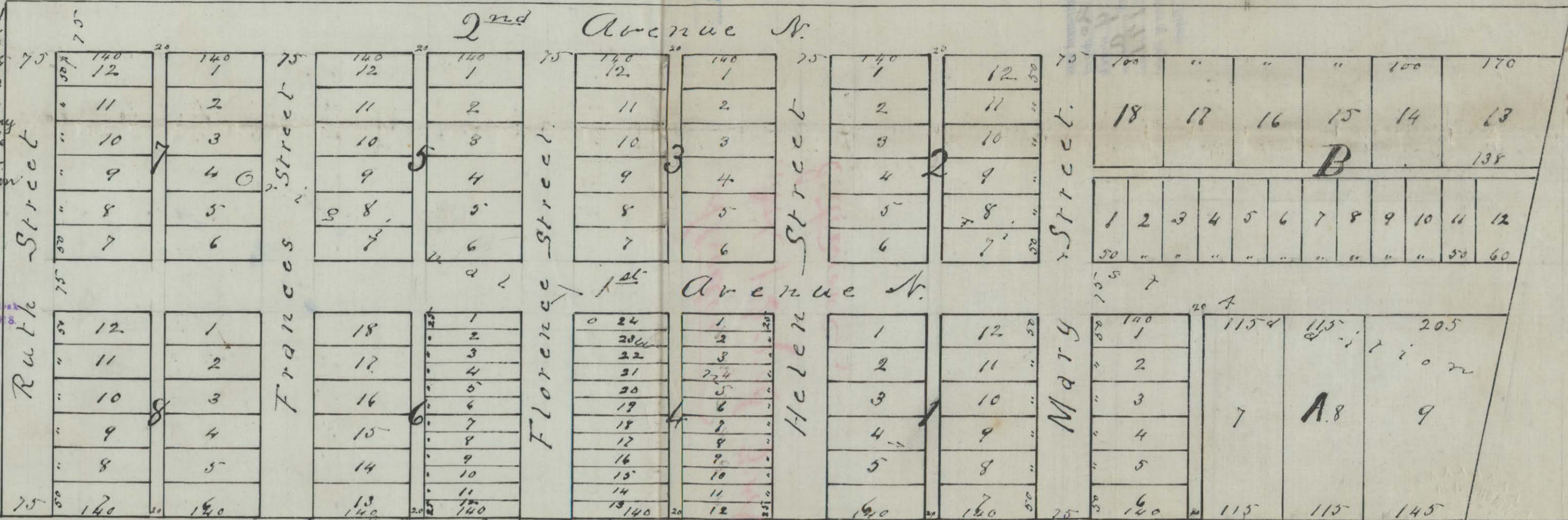


Streeter, North Dakota, with First, Second and Third Extensions as laid out by the Smith Land Company.

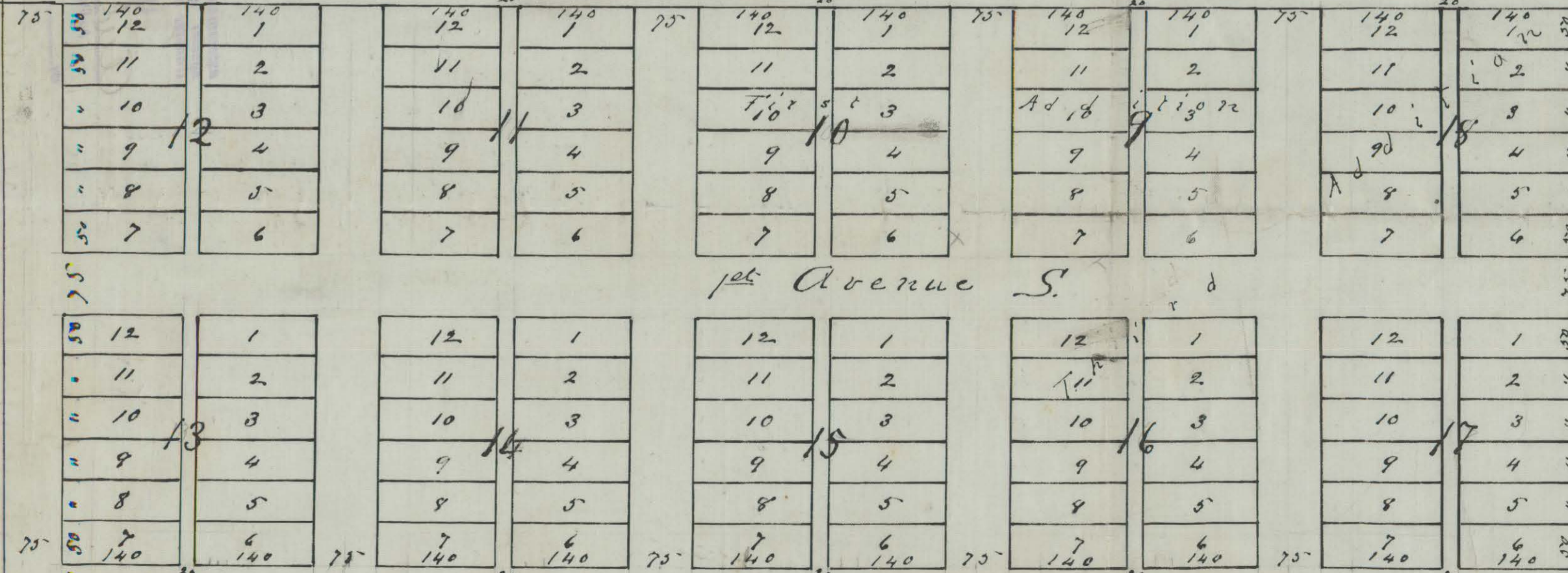
We, the undersigned ~~representing~~ the Smith Land Company hereby dedicate all the land, known in this plat as the Smith Land Company's Third Extension to Streeter, and designated in the same as Streets and Alleys, to the public for use as such and for no other purpose.

The survey of the 3rd extension to Streeter, Stutsman county North Dakota, was made by the authority of the Smith Land Company and is follows: Beginning 75 feet South of the S. E. corner of Block 15 of the 2nd addition to Streeter according to the official plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Registrar of Deeds of Stutsman county, and 75 feet E. of the East line thereof. Thence E. 750 feet; thence N. 750 feet to S. Boundary of N. P. R. R. yard; thence N. 375 and along said boundary to a point 75 feet E. of N. E. corner of Block 9 of original town; thence S. and parallel to E. line of same, 375 feet; thence N. 375 feet to a point 75 feet E. of N. E. corner of Block 15; thence S. 375 feet to place of beginning enclosing the 3rd extension to Streeter. I then subdivided the enclosed parcel of land into blocks, lots, streets and alleys as shown in this plat which is a correct map of the survey. These extensions are known as the Smith Land, 600 extensions to Streeter and are as shown. All angles, right angled.
