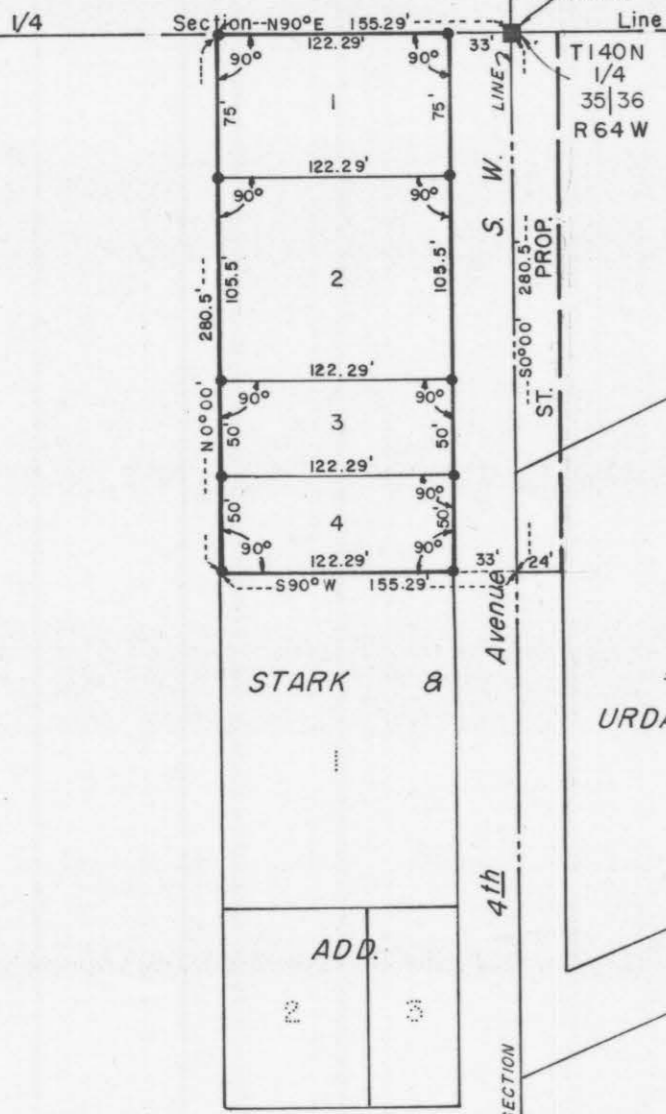


WHEELER'S ADDITION TO THE CITY OF JAMESTOWN, NORTH DAKOTA

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, Floyd D. Larson, North Central Engineers, a Registered Land Surveyor, in the State of North Dakota, do hereby certify that this plat is a true and correct representation of Wheeler's Addition to the City of Jamestown, North Dakota, as surveyed and platted by me in accordance with the statutes of the State of North Dakota and ordinances of the City of Jamestown, North Dakota, in such case made and provided.

The land platted in said Wheeler's Addition is part of the SE 1/4 of Section 35, T140N, R64W and is more particularly described as follows, to wit: Beginning at the Northeast corner of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of Section 35, T140N, R64W, thence South 0° 00' along East side of said quarter a distance of 280.5 feet to a point, thence South 90° 00' West a distance of 155.29 feet to a point, thence North 0° 00' a distance of 280.5 feet to a point, thence North 90° 00' East a distance of 155.29 feet to the point of beginning.
